
What is software management

Software management cost analysis

- \$60 per application per year to manually install and update software

- \$320,000/year for a 1000 node network with 4 applications per node






Peer to Peer Structure


- "No need for Server to be running or even present
- Send a distribution to a remote PC without being able to see the remote Server it is attached to
- Independent of file server domains and Network Operating System
- Supports most LAN transport protocols
 - Runs on any network using IPX, IPC, NetBIOS, or TCP/IP transport protocols
 - Supports Multi-protocol support

Scalability: use on any size network
You won't outgrow NetWizard


Efficiency: minimize repetitive WAN traffic




BM receives distributions from main manager once and distributes them to the proper nodes in its branch...



BM collects inventory and metering information from remote Agents and sends it to the main NetWizard Manager once over expensive WAN links.




Cascaded BMs allow Distribution Fan Out




Cascaded BMs allow Distribution Fan Out



Safe Software Management


Distribution Automatic Rollback and Recovery

When an error condition is encountered, distribution is automatically undone, returning the Agent PC to its previous condition. Target PC is left unaffected.

Distribution UNDO Capability

At Administrator's discretion, distributions can be rolled-back off of the Agent's PC.









Double-Click to open a directory or file on a remote node and view or editits contents


"Navigate interactively through agent directory trees

To Copy or Delete files and directories, simply drag the desired icon to another




- Quickly and effortlessly copy files from node to node(s) or delete files at a node(s) interactively.
- Directory structure is automatically recreated at the target node, if not already present.


Node Status Screen





NetWizard Package Recorder

Package Recorder greatly reduces script development time

- Record installation of shrink-wrapped or custom application using Package Recorder
 - Use Package Editor to automatically generate a NetWizard distribution script from recording
 - Add conditional logic & special commands using NetWizard Visual Script Editors




License Enforcement

Eliminates risk of license violations

- License enforcement for several licensing policies:
 - Concurrent use, Site license, Per user or per workstation, or Suite licenses
- Varying enforcement levels: Silent, Warning, or Strict
- License queuing
- Prioritized license distribution
- Usage time limits



NetWizard - Plus Pack

- 1. Remote Control NetWizard administrators can dynamically "take-over" remote machines with redirected video, keyboard, and mouse i/o. Supports all NetWizard platforms except Windows NT.
- 2. Modem connectivity between NetWizard components NetWizard manager can communicate with remote nodes and remote nodes can communicate with the NetWizard manager using Asynch dial-out via RAS or any compatible interface. (RAS clients to RLN Servers for example).
- 3. Windows 95/NT Policy Management NetWizard administrator can centrally define Windows 95 and Windows NT "policies" and distribute them (implement them) electronically using the new Policy Editor.
