

Welcome to the Ideas That Changed The World CD-ROM

v 2.0.2

Windows 3.1 and 3.11 Users

Below are the instructions for installing Ideas That Changed The World on your computer operating under Windows 3.x.

- (1) Insert the CD-ROM into your CD-ROM Drive.
- (2) From the Program Manager's FILE menu, select RUN
- (3) On the line marked COMMAND LINE, Enter x:\windows\setup.exe, where x: is your CD-ROM drive letter.
- (4) Select OK
- (5) At the installer welcome screen, select "Next".
- (6) When the installer begins it will ask for the directory to which you want the files needed to run "IDEAS" installed. The default is x:\IDEAS, where x: is your main Hard Drive letter. (ie: C:\IDEAS).
- (7) You will be asked to indicate which components you would like to install from the CD-ROM. The choices are:
 - "Ideas That Changed the World Program Group"
 - "Quicktime(tm) v2.03"
 - "Ideas That Changed the World Parent-Teacher's Guide"

By default the first two items are selected but you may select any combination you wish.

N.B. If you do not install Quicktime(tm) and you do not already have Quicktime(tm) installed on your computer, Ideas That Changed the World will not run properly. Also, if you do not install the "Ideas That Changed the World" program group you will not be able to run Ideas from your desktop.

You may re-run the installer at any time to install components that you have not already installed.

- (8) Select "Next" and "IDEAS" will install to your hard drive.
- (9) Once the files needed have been installed, the QuickTime 2.03 Installer will automatically run. Follow the instructions on the screen, allowing the deletion and replacement of older versions of QuickTime that the installer finds.
- (10) After QuickTime has been installed, the computer will restart Windows so that changes made will take effect.

To start the program:

Make sure that the Ideas That Changed the World CD-ROM is in your CD-ROM drive, double click on the icon marked Ideas That Changed the World , in the program group named Ideas That Changed the World .

Windows 95 Users

Below are the instructions for installing Ideas That Changed The World on your computer operating under Windows 95.

- (1) Insert the CD-ROM into your CD-ROM Drive.
- (2) From the START menu at the bottom left of the Windows interface, select RUN... .
- (3) On the line marked COMMAND LINE, Enter x:\windows\setup.exe, where x: is your CD-ROM drive letter.
- (4) Select OK
- (5) At the installer welcome screen, select "Next".
- (6) When the installer begins it will ask for the directory to which you want the files needed to run "IDEAS" installed. The default is x:\IDEAS, where x: is your main Hard Drive letter. (ie: C:\IDEAS).
- (7) You will be asked to indicate which components you would like to install from the CD-ROM. The choices are:
 - "Ideas That Changed the World Program Group"
 - "Quicktime(tm) v2.03"
 - "Ideas That Changed the World Parent-Teacher's Guide"

By default the first two items are selected but you may select any combination you wish.

- (8) Select "Next" and "IDEAS" will install to your hard drive.
- (9) Once the files needed have been installed, the QuickTime 2.03 Installer will automatically run. Follow the instructions on the screen, allowing the deletion and replacement of older versions of QuickTime that the installer finds.

To start the program:

Make sure that the Ideas That Changed the World CD-ROM is in your CD-ROM drive, click on the START menu, select PROGRAMS from the menu, then click on the program item Ideas That Changed the World . Finally, select the Ideas That Changed the World icon.

If you experience problems with your video board, sound board, or CD-ROM, there is a file called Technical Read Me, located in Ideas That Changed the World program group/menu that contains manufacturer's technical support information.

Also included on this CD-ROM are a Parent-Teacher Guide and ICE CD Product Demo located in their respective directories ("GUIDE" & "DEMO").

The Parent-Teacher guide can be viewed and printed out using the Common Ground MiniViewer application.

To view the Parent-Teacher Guide: Make sure that you select "Install Ideas Parent-Teacher Guide" when choosing components in the installer. If you did not select "Install Ideas Parent-Teacher Guide", you can re-run the installer and install it now. This will add two icons to the "Ideas That Changed the World" program group, one for the guide and one for the answers. Double-click either icon to view the document.

To print out the Parent-Teacher Guide: View the document and select Print from the File menu.

The icon for the Demo has been placed in the program group window by the installer (Windows 3.x) or in the programs menu (Windows 95). The file "DEMO.EXE" can also be opened by double clicking it in Windows Explorer (Windows 95), or in the File Manager (Windows 3.1).

* Assuming the installer for this CD-ROM has been run; or that QuickTime 2.0.3 is already on your computer.
