



**Dear Parent,**

Group's Serengeti Trek is partnering with World Vision (an international relief organization) and International Bible Society to provide school supply kits for children in Africa. These children have been deprived of basic supplies needed for learning. You and your child can help needy children learn and grow through a small contribution.



Each Safari Crew of about five children is on a special mission. They're putting together a school supply kit made up of the items pictured here. In Chadder's Adventure Theater, crew members work together to choose the items each person will donate. The one or two items checked (or circled) are what your child volunteered to donate.

**Each kit must include precisely the same items** so that foreign customs officials will not delay or prevent delivery. For example, the crayons must be 24-count, not 16 or 48. This also prevents disappointment on the part of children who otherwise might not receive as much as others. Thanks for remembering that as you purchase the items.

**Items must be new and in their original packaging.** The children receiving these kits seldom get anything new. Leaving items in their original packaging will create more excitement for them as they open their kits. (Product brand doesn't matter. The items pictured are simply examples of what you might send.)

**Children must bring their items to their Safari Crew Leaders by the last day of Serengeti Trek.** If you are unable to donate the item(s) checked, please circle this paragraph and have your child return this sheet to his or her crew leader.
