This file simulates the 1-2-3 window synchronization capability. Every time return is pressed, the macro which remains in "background" evaluates the cursor position, if there is no change, nothing happens, if the window has changed, the cursor goes to the other window and brings that row to the window. The cursor then returns to the original window and waits for the next press of RETURN.
