

MEMBRAIN.EXE creates a file named 'MEMBRAIN.SYS', a DOS device driver for an emulated disk drive configured to your specifications. DOS will assign to the drive the next available drive letter. For example, if your system has two diskette drives (A & B), then the emulated drive will be drive C. The emulated drive will function identically to a hardware drive with a few exceptions. First, this drive need not and cannot be formatted. Second, when you turn the system off, the drive ceases to exist. Be sure to copy any files that must be saved to a hardware drive before power off. Third, it's fast!!!
