## **General Instructions**

Walker is a program executor for Windows. To run a program just enter its full name and path in the Command Line window.

Walker supports file associations. Entering a file with an extension not equal to EXE causes Walker to search the [Extensions] section of your WIN.INI file. In this section filename extensions are associated with a certain program. For example, a DOC extension might be associated with a word processor. In this example entering a DOC filename into Walker will cause your word processor to be executed with the DOC file as a parameter. You can easily examine and/or edit your WIN.INI file using the Windows-supplied program SysEdit. For more information see your Windows User Guide.

## **Registration**

The use of Walker is subject to the following terms and conditions:

Walker is copyrighted material, protected by the copyright laws of the United States. You may not make any changes or modifications, decompile, disassemble, or otherwise reverse-engineer the software in any way.

## Six-Pack For Windows

Registering entitles you to a copy of Six-Pack For Windows which contains the latest version of Walker.

Six-Pack For Windows contains the following:

**Red Button** Red Button lets you exit Windows quickly. Red Button runs as an icon that looks like a red button. When you double click on the red button you will exit Windows. An optional warning dialog is available.

**Launcher** An application launcher that allows you to easily traverse directories to find an application and run it.

**Runner** Runner mimics the Program Managers File/Run dialog. Since Runner is not a dialog you can have Runner available at any time to launch applications.

**Walker** A minimalist version of Runner. An edit box that accepts an application and it's path upon hitting the return key and runs it.

**PayOff** A loan payoff amount calculator for Windows.

**SnapShot** SnapShot is an easy to use screen capture program for Windows that allows you to capture a window, the entire screen or any portion of the screen by enabling the right mouse button as a shutter for SnapShot's screen capture function. Each captured image is made available to other applications via the Windows clipboard.
