Installing *substance.digizine*

To install *substance* to your hard drive, select "RUN" from the Program Manager menu bar and type "D:\INSTALL" ("D" being the letter of your CD-ROM drive). You can also run "INSTALL" through Windows File Manager by logging onto your CD-ROM drive and double-clicking on the "INSTALL.EXE" file found in the root directory of this disc.

The installation program will prompt you for the directory you wish to install the digizine files into, and will also prompt you if you do not have QuickTime For Windows installed on your system. The installation program will copy about 6MB of files to your hard drive. If you do not have this much free space available on your system, you cannot run the digizine. You must also have your sound card and CD-ROM drive properly installed. Please review the "HELP.WRI" file if you encounter any problems running *substance* on your system.

Playing CD audio tracks

This disc also contains a **20-minute EP** of original music (tracks 2-6 on the CD-ROM) which is playable on any standard audio CD player. **CAUTION: DO NOT TRY TO PLAY TRACK 1 ON YOUR AUDIO CD PLAYER!** Track 1 is a data track and could cause severe damage to your speakers and stereo system if you attempt to play it. When playing the CD-ROM in an audio CD player, skip ahead to track 2.

Using the cursors

The following cursors will help you navigate your way around the digizine:



This cursor allows for vertical movement forward in a hierarchical order of screens (i.e. from menu to submenu).



This cursor allows for vertical movement backward in a hierarchical order of screens (i.e. from submenu to menu).



This cursor allows for lateral movement forward in a page-by-page sequence (i.e. from page 1 to page 2).



This cursor allows for lateral movement backward in a page-by-page sequence (i.e. from page 2 to page 1).



This cursor will reveal further options or hidden information.



This cursor indicates where hypertext links are located.



This cursor indicates where a sound sample will be played.



This cursor indicates where a video sample will be played.

Other user tips

The content and exit icons will appear at the bottom left and right corners of your screen by moving the mouse into these regions. You may also exit the digizine at any time by pressing the **Esc** key on your keyboard. You will not be prompted to quit, so make sure you wish to exit the digizine at this time.

If you are experiencing performance problems while running the disc, try closing all other active applications and then restart it. If it is still running slow, exit Windows and restart. This should free up more RAM for you.
