CERTIORARI -- SUMMARY DISPOSITION

92-1183 KNOX, STEPHEN V. UNITED STATES

The motion of National Law Center for Children and Families, et al. for leave to participate in oral argument as *amici curiae* and for divided argument is dismissed as moot. The motion of National Family Legal Foundation for leave to participate in oral argument as *amicus curiae* is dismissed as moot. The judgment is vacated and the case is remanded to the United States Court of Appeals for the Third Circuit for further consideration in light of the position asserted by the Solicitor General in his brief for the United States filed September 17, 1993.
