Comments : The LameBlame virus allocates CHIP-Memory for it's location. After Copying the virus into this AREA it patches the CoolCapture vector and the DoIO() to infect other disks.

The whole virusbootblock will be crypted by an byte depending of \$dff006 so you can't read any texts in the bootblock.

The virus isn't dangerous for HD-Users because it tests for the trackdisk.device. After every 8th Alert the virus gives out an ALERT:

"LameBlame! by Tai-Pan - Nimber of Copys:0002"
