• The **past simple** of **regular verbs** is constructed by adding **-ed** or **-d** to the verb in the infinitive. The verbs that end with **-y** have a past tense ending of **-ied** if **y** is placed after a consonant.

<u>Example</u>: Yesterday I watched a movie. The baby cried a lot last night.

- The construction of the **irregular verbs** in the **past simple does not have a precise rule**, they must therefore be learnt by heart.
 - <u>Example</u>: When did (to do) you first meet him? I first met (to meet) him yesterday. I went (to go) to Spain 15 years ago.
