• The **past simple** of **regular verbs** is constructed by adding **-ed** or **-d** to the verb in the infinitive. The verbs that end with **-**y have a past tense ending of **-ied** if y is placed after a consonant.

> *Example*: Yesterday I **watched** a movie. The baby **cried** a lot last night.

- The construction of the **irregular verbs** in the **past simple does not have a precise rule**, they must therefore be learnt by heart.
 - *Example*: When **did** (to do) you first meet him? I first **met** (to meet) him yesterday. I **went** (to go) to Spain 15 years ago.
