System Requirements:

MapIt 1.0 **requires** Microsoft Windows 3.1, a 286 or better CPU, and a hard drive. Printing requires a printer properly configured for Windows.

Included files:

mapit.exe	executable file
mapit.hlp	Online Help file
sample.mit	sample file

mapit.ini	initialization file
readme.wri	this file
order.txt	an order form for registration
BWCC.DLL	DLL for some display functions.

Installing Mapit 1.0

Copy mapit.exe, mapit.hlp, sample.mit, and readme.wri to whatever directory you wish. Copy mapit.ini to your **Windows** directory (if Mapit doesn't the file there, it will use default information). Copy the file BWCC.DLL to your WINDOWS\SYSTEM directory. And that's it! Mapit does not modify any other files on your hard drive.

Command Line Usage:

MAPIT [path[filename]]

If the file you wish to open resides in the same directory as mapit.exe then no [path] is necessary. Files can be added to any Program Manager Group, enabling you to start Mapit with the file preloaded (see your Windows documentation for directions on adding files to Groups). Note that the ability to open a file from the command line (or from a Group) requires you to associate Mapit's files with the executable file from File Manager (refer to your Windows documentation).
