## THE INTERNET'S EXPLOSIVE

The graph on the left shows how total data traffic on the Internet has grown: from 85 million data packets a month in January 1988 to over 60 billion packets a month in January 1995. The graph on the right shows how three selected types of transmission have mushroomed over the past two years. Although the volume of

regular e-mail and file transfers has grown steadily, it is the World-Wide Web that has suddenly become the fastest-growing part of the Internet, thanks largely to the recent availability of Windows-based Web-browsing tools.
