

## Ten Viruses to Watch Out For

<b>The chart below lists 10 viruses you should watch out for.</b>				
Some are very recent, so they can't be detected by many anti-virus programs.				
Others are just old enemies, difficult to kill, that keep coming back and causing damage.				
We've listed each virus' origin and destructive action, and some guaranteed cures.				
The anti-virus programs listed in the Known Removal Methods column are Dr. Solomon's Anti-Virus Toolkit 7, F-Prot 2.16, McAfee's VirusScan 2.1, and Symantec's Norton Anti-Virus 3.0.				
These four are the most popular anti-virus programs presently being used, not counting the anti-virus program already contained in MS-DOS 6.xx.				
They are by no means a comprehensive list, however. If you contract any of the listed viruses, try the latest version of your favorite anti-virus program before running out and buying a new one -- you never know.

<b>Espejo</b>	Mexico, 1994	Prints Spanish message, and increases size of COM and EXE files	None	F-Prot can detect, but no
<b>Forms</b>	Zurich, 1990	Attacks boot sector, prints text message, and marks some data sectors as bad	None	F-Prot, VirusScan
<b>Junkie</b>	Sweden, 1994	Infects Main Boot Record, boot sector, and FAT	Junkie-A; Junkie-B	F-Prot, Solomon
<b>Michelangelo</b>	Country unknown, 1991	Activates March 6 every year, destroys data by overwriting sectors 1-17 on heads 0-3 of all tracks	Ninja Turtle Virus	F-Prot, Norton Anti-Virus, Solomon, VirusScan
<b>Monkey</b>	Canada, 1991 Sweden, 1994	Encrypts and hides Master Boot Record Increases COM and EXE files by 1,329 bytes	Monkey-2 None	F-Prot, Solomon, VirusScan Scitzo F-Prot, Solomon
<b>Tai-Pan.666</b>	U.S.A., 1994	Infects EXE files, prints a screen text message, and replicates	Doom II Death Virus	F-Prot, Solomon
