#### Overview

Password Keeper for Windows 95/NT is a small utility for storing your frequently used passwords. Password information can be stored, edited and printed with this easy to use program.

Each password file that you create can contain up to 1000 account entries. You will never forget a password again with this handy utility installed on your Windows 95/NT system. Password Keeper includes a facility to optionally generate random alphanumeric passwords automatically. These passwords will be difficult for others to guess.

Password Keeper data files are stored in an encrypted format to prevent unauthorized users from accessing and viewing them. Passwords can be copied to the Clipboard and pasted into other login programs.

Please remember the file access password you assign to your Password Keeper document. This password is used to encrypt the actual account records stored in the document. Without this password you will not be able to access the documents you create. There is no way to recover the account record data without this password, so please remember the password you assign.

# Other Uses

Password Keeper can also be used to store PIN numbers and safe combinations. Any private access information that needs to be saved in a secure location can be stored in Password Keepers files.

# Web Site URL Addresses

Password Keeper can also be used store a web site address for each account record. You can use Password Keeper to automatically launch your web browser and go directly to a web site on the Internet.

#### Purchasing

Password Keeper for Windows 95/NT is a fully functioning program, it is not time-limited or crippled in any way.

Password Keeper for Windows 95/NT is distributed as <u>shareware</u>. You may evaluate it free of charge for 30 days. After 30 days if you continue to use Password Keeper for Windows 95/NT you are required to <u>register</u> it. If after evaluating Password Keeper for 30 days you decide not to register it you are required to <u>remove</u> it from your computer.

Registration entitles you to unlimited free updates and support via E-Mail or telephone.

# **Desktop Locations**

Password Keeper's location on the desktop is saved when the program is exited. Whenever you start Password Keeper it will reappear on the desktop where you last placed it. Password Keeper property sheet locations are also stored and reused the next time they are opened.

# Taskbar Tray

Password Keeper for Windows 95/NT can be optionally configured to place its program icon in the Taskbar Icon Notification Tray. This option provides a simple means of keeping the taskbar button region clear for other running programs.

# **Installing Password Keeper**

#### Installation

To install Password Keeper for Windows 95/NT on your computer simply create a new, empty folder and place the files; PASSKEEP.EXE, PASSKEEP.HLP and PASSKEEP.CNT there.

PASSKEEP.EXE - The Password Keeper Application
PASSKEEP.HLP - The Windows 95/NT Help File
PASSKEEP.CNT - The Help Contents File

If you use the SETUP.EXE program and specify the default installation directory Password Keeper will be copied to the C:\
Program Files\Software by Design folder.

To integrate Password Keeper for Windows 95/NT with the MS Windows Explorer select the Password Keeper <u>Explorer Setup</u> property sheet while Password Keeper is running.

**Note** If you have an earlier version of Password Keeper for Windows 95/NT installed on your computer, simply replace the PASSKEEP.EXE, PASSKEEP.HLP and PASSKEEP.CNT files with the newer versions. Password Keeper stores configuration information in the MS Windows 95/NT <u>System Registry</u>.

**Note** The PASSKEEP.INI file is no longer used and can be deleted. The various application settings specified in the <u>Password Keeper Options</u> property sheet as well as the main window's size and location on the desktop are now stored in the MS Windows 95/NT System Registry.

**Note** Some earlier versions of Password Keeper for Windows 95/NT included a PASSKEEP.WRI documentation file. This file has been replaced by the PASSKEEP.HLP file and can now be deleted.

**Warning** If you rename the PASSKEEP.EXE file you must also rename the HLP file using the same basename. For example if you change the Password Keeper application file name to NewName.exe, rename the help file to NewName.hlp as well. The HLP file *must* reside in the same folder as the Password Keeper application file itself.

# **Configuring Password Keeper**

# **Password Keeper Options**

Select the **File | Options** menu item to display the Password Keeper Options property sheet. This window will allow you to change the various Password Keeper program settings listed below.

# Place Icon in the Taskbar Tray

Check this item to display a small Password Keeper program icon in the Taskbar Icon Notification Tray. If this item is selected and the Password Keeper window is minimized a button will not be added to the Taskbar, to restore the Password Keeper window on the desktop press the small icon in the taskbar tray instead. This option is available to keep the taskbar free for other running programs.

**Note** When this option is selected, clicking on the Close box in the upper-right hand corner of the window title bar will minimize Password Keeper instead of closing the application. To quit Password Keeper right-click with your mouse on the Password Keeper icon in the Taskbar tray. You may also use the **File | Exit** menu command or the **Ctrl+Q** keyboard shortcut.

# Minimize Program Icon at Startup

Check this item to minimize the main window on the Taskbar or Icon tray when Password Keeper is first started.

# **Confirm Program Exit**

Check this item to confirm quitting Password Keeper for Windows 95/NT. When this option is selected you will be prompted to confirm your intention to exit Password Keeper and return to the MS Explorer desktop. This item is useful if you run Password Keeper from the tray and wish to avoid accidental exits when you right-click on the Password Keeper tray icon.

# **Show Tool Bar Tips**

Check this item to display small popup tip windows when the mouse pointer is placed over <u>toolbar ribbon</u> pushbuttons. A short description of the button currently beneath the mouse will be shown when this item is checked.

# Dark Window Backgrounds

Check this item to display the text in list windows with a dark background instead of the paper white background MS Windows normally uses when displaying text.

# Reopen the Last File Used at Startup

Check this box to reopen the last password file used when Password Keeper is launched.

# **Save Changes Automatically**

Check this box to automatically save editing changes when a password document is closed. If this box is not checked you will be prompted before closing documents that have changed.

# Sounds with Warning Dialog Boxes

Check this box to play a short beep sound when Password Keeper displays a warning dialog box or an error occurs.

# OK

Press this button when you have completed your selection of Password Keeper program options. When you press this button the Password Keeper Options property sheet will be closed and your settings will be saved.

# Cancel

Press this button to close the Password Keeper Options property sheet without making any changes. If you have made any changes to the option settings, and then press this button your changes will not be used, and your previous settings will remain in use.

# Help

Press this button to open the Password Keeper Help Window and go directly to the Configuring Password Keeper topic.

**Note** The options you have selected will be saved when you press the **OK** button. The desktop location of the Password Keeper Options window itself will also be stored.

# **Password Keeper Security Settings**

# **Password Keeper Security Settings**

Select the **File | Options** menu item to display the Password Keeper Options property sheet, then select the **Security** tab. This window will allow you to change the various Password Keeper security settings listed below.

# **Time Period to Display Account Password**

Specify the time period to display account password information before hiding the selected entry again. The time period to display a password can be between 1 and 120 seconds (2 minutes).

# Minimize Windows on Display Timeout

Check this item to minimize the Password Keeper main window to an icon on the Taskbar or Notification Tray when the display period defined above has elapsed.

# Always Show Information

Check this item to show the selected account password indefinitely, instead of hiding it after a short display period.

# Length for Randomly Generated Passwords

Enter the length to be used when generating random account passwords. The password length you specify can be between 4 and 46 characters. This value will be used when random alphanumeric passwords are generated.

# **Display Password with Account Record**

Check this item to show the currently selected account record password. If this item is unchecked the password for the currently selected account record will be replaced with a '\*\*\*\*\*\*\* hidden text string.

**Note** The password associated with the currently selected account record will still be available for Copy / Paste operations into other login programs, but will not appear in the Password Keeper window if the option above is left unchecked.

#### OK

Press this button when you have completed your selection of Password Keeper program options. When you press this button the Password Keeper Options property sheet will be closed and your settings will be saved.

### Cancel

Press this button to close the Password Keeper Options property sheet without making any changes. If you have made any changes to the option settings, and then press this button your changes will not be used, and your previous settings will remain in use.

# Help

Press this button to open the Password Keeper Help Window and go directly to the Password Keeper Security Settings topic.

**Note** The options you have selected will be saved when you press the **OK** button. The desktop location of the Password Keeper Options window itself will also be stored.

# **Password Keeper Page Setup**

# Password Keeper Page Setup

Password Keeper can be configured to use custom headers and footers when printing Password Keeper documents using the **Eile | Page Setup** menu item.

# **Password Keeper File Information Macros**

Displayed below is a list of Password Keeper File Information Macros available for inclusion in custom headers and footers.

<b>\$F</b> = File Name	The current document name with full drive and path will be inserted at the point where the \$F macro appears
<b>\$f</b> = File Name	The current document name without a drive or path will be inserted at the point where the \$f macro appears
<b>\$P</b> = Page Number	The current page number will be inserted at the point where the \$P macro appears
<b>\$T</b> = Current Time	The current time will be inserted at the point the \$T macro appears
<b>\$D</b> = Current Date	The current date in long format will be inserted at the point the \$D macro appears
\$d = Current Date	The current date in short format will be inserted at the point the \$d macro appears

Any other text specified in a header or footer will be treated as literal and will appear just as defined. To include the actual '\$' character in a header or footer use '\$\$'.

# **Header**

Define the header text you wish to have appear at the top of each page printed. See the File Information Macros section above for a complete description of those items that can automatically be included in a header.

#### **Print Header**

Check this item to enable the header defined above. If this item is not checked the header you defined above will not be printed. This item is included to facilitate turning header printing on and off with out deleting the header you have defined

# Center Header

Check this item to center the header at the top of each printed page. If this item is not checked the header you have defined above will be printed starting at the left margin.

# Footer

Define the footer text you wish to have appear at the bottom of each page printed. See the File Information Macros section above for a complete description of those items that can automatically be included in a footer.

# **Print Footer**

Check this item to enable the footer defined above. If this item is not checked the footer you defined above will not be printed. This item is included to facilitate turning footer printing on and off with out deleting the footer you have defined

# **Center Footer**

Check this item to center the footer at the bottom of each printed page. If this item is not checked the footer you have defined above will be printed starting at the left margin.

# **Printer Page Margins**

Use the following four entry fields to specify the page margins to be used when printing documents. Margin widths are expressed in decimal inches, for example 1.25, 0.50, .25 or 1 are all valid margin widths.

# Left

Enter the left margin width in this field. Document text will be printed starting from this position on the left side on the page.

# Right

Enter the right margin width in this field. Document text will be printed across the page to this position.

# Top

Enter the top margin width in this field. Document text will be printed starting from this position at the top of the page.

# Bottom

Enter the bottom margin width in this field. Document text will be printed down to this position at the bottom of the page.

**Note** If you have defined a header or footer to be printed on each page make certain that you set the top and bottom margin widths to at least 0.10 inches or your document text will be printed directly on top of the headers and footers you defined.

# ΟK

Press this button when you have completed your selection of Page Setup settings. When you press this button the Page Setup property sheet will be closed and your settings will be saved.

# Cancel

Press this button to close the Page Setup property sheet without making any changes. If you have made any changes to the Page Setup settings, and then press this button your changes will not be used, and your previous settings will remain in use.

# Help

Press this button to open the Password Keeper Help window and go directly to the Password Keeper Page Setup topic.

**Note** The Page Setup settings you have selected will be saved when you press the **OK** button. The desktop location of the Page Setup window itself will also be stored. Your Page Setup settings will be saved in the MS Windows 95/NT <u>System Registry</u>.

# Password Keeper Explorer Setup

# **Password Keeper Explorer Setup**

Select the **Help | Setup** menu item to display the Password Keeper Explorer Setup property sheet. This window will allow you to integrate Password Keeper for Windows 95/NT with the Microsoft Windows 95/NT Explorer. Use this command to create and remove MS Explorer shortcuts.

#### Create a Start Menu Item

Check this item to create a Password Keeper Start Menu entry. The Password Keeper for Windows 95/NT program will be located in the Software by Design folder on the Programs menu. This item will be disabled (grayed) if a Password Keeper item already exists in the Software by Design folder.

# Remove this Start Menu Item

Check this item to remove the Password Keeper entry located in the Software by Design folder on the Programs menu. This item will be disabled (grayed) if a Password Keeper item does not already exist in the Software by Design folder.

### Create a Desktop Icon

Check this item to create a Password Keeper for Windows 95/NT program icon on the Explorer desktop. This item will be disabled (grayed) if a Password Keeper desktop icon already exists.

# Remove Icon from the Desktop

Check this item to remove the Password Keeper for Windows 95/NT program icon from the Explorer desktop. This item will be disabled (grayed) if a Password Keeper desktop icon does not already exist.

# Create a Startup Folder Item

Check this item to automatically run Password Keeper for Windows 95/NT whenever Microsoft Windows is started. This option creates a Password Keeper program icon in the MS Windows Explorer Startup folder. This item will be disabled (grayed) if a Password Keeper startup item already exists in the Startup folder.

# Remove the Startup Folder Item

Check this item to remove Password Keeper from the MS Windows Explorer Startup folder. This item will be disabled (grayed) if a Password Keeper startup item does not already exist in the Startup folder.

### OK

Press this button when you have completed your selection of MS Explorer shortcuts. When you press this button the Password Keeper Explorer Setup property sheet will be closed and the MS Explorer shortcuts you have selected will be created or removed.

# Cancel

Press this button to close the Password Keeper Explorer Setup property sheet without creating or removing any MS Explorer shortcuts.

# Help

Press this button to open the Password Keeper Help window and go directly to the Password Keeper Explorer Setup topic.

# **Editing Account Entries**

# **Editing Account Entries**

Password Keeper account entries are easily created and edited using the Editor window. Select **Edit | Add Account** or **Edit | Edit Account** to display the Password Keeper Account Editing window.

When either of these commands is selected a property sheet will be displayed. Use this property sheet to create new account entries or edit existing records. The entry fields available are described below.

# **Account Name**

Use this field to store the account name for this Password Keeper database entry. This field will normally be filled with the name of the account this password record is used with, for example America Online, or CompuServe. This field must be filled.

### Login Name

Use this field to record your login name for this account. This will normally be your user name for this login account.

#### Password

Use this field to store your login access password for this account. Press the [...] button to the right of this entry field to have Password Keeper generate a random alphanumeric password entry for you automatically. This facility is useful if you would like to create a password that will be difficult for others to guess.

#### Web Site URL

Use this field to store an optional web site URL address for this account. If this field is filled you can use the Visit URL command to automatically launch your web browser and go directly to the web site on the internet.

Note If the current account record includes a password it will be copied to the Clipboard prior to launching your web browser.

#### **Notes and Comments**

Use this entry field to store any notes or comments you would like to record for this account record.

#### ΩK

Press this button when you have completed editing the current Password Keeper account entry. When you press this button the Password Keeper Account Editing window will be closed and your changes will be saved.

# Cance

Press this button to close the Password Keeper Account Editing windows without making any changes. If you have made any changes to the account record, and then press this button your changes will not be saved, and your previous entries will remain unchanged.

# Help

Press this button to open the Password Keeper Help Window and go directly to the Editing Account Entries topic.

# **File Access Password**

# File Access Password

Please remember the file access password you use for your Password Keeper document files, this is the password you assigned when you created your Password Keeper file. This password key is used to encrypt the document file itself, without this password you will not be able to access the documents you create or the account records that they contain.

**Note** Password Keeper file access passwords are case sensitive, so always enter the file access password exactly as you originally assigned it.

# File Menu

# File Menu Commands

The File menu provides commands to work with the document files used by Password Keeper. A short description of each item follows:

### New

Creates a new Password Keeper document. You will be prompted to assign a document access password to the file you are creating. The **Ctrl+N** shortcut can be used for this command.

# **O**pen

Opens an existing Password Keeper document, and loads it for editing or viewing. When this item is selected the standard MS Windows Explorer file browser will be displayed, use this window to select the document you wish to work with. Check the **Open as Read-Only** box to load documents for viewing only. You will be prompted to enter the document access password for the file you select. This is the password you assigned to the file when it was created. The **Ctrl+O** shortcut can be used for this command.

# **Properties**

Displays a small window showing file properties for the currently selected Password Keeper document. This window will display the document's file name, folder location, size, last modification date and file access permissions. The **Alt+Enter** shortcut can be used for this command.

# Close

Closes the currently active document. If the document has been edited you will be prompted to save or discard the changes before closing. The **Ctrl+W** shortcut can be used for this command.

# <u>S</u>ave

Saves changes made to the currently selected document. This menu will be disabled (grayed) if no changes have been made to the document since it was last loaded or saved. The **Ctrl+S** shortcut can be used for this command.

# Save As

Saves the currently active document with a new name. When this item is selected the standard MS Windows Explorer file browser will be displayed, use this window to specify a new name for the document. You will be prompted to assign a new password and verify it before the file is saved with the new name and access password you have selected.

# Page Setup

Opens the <a href="Page-Setup">Page Setup</a> property sheet and allows you to change Password Keeper printer page layout settings.

# Printer Setup

This command allows you to select a printer and set various printer options using the standard MS Windows 95/NT Printer Setup dialog box.

Tip Use this command to quickly select the Landscape mode for printing Password Keeper account lists.

# **Printer Font**

This command allows you to select a font for printing using the standard MS Windows 95/NT Font dialog box.

**Tip** Select a small 7 or 8 pt. font for printed Password Keeper account lists. You might also want to try using Microsoft Small Fonts at 6 or 7 pt. to display account lists with long web site URL addresses.

# **Print**

Prints the currently selected Password Keeper document on your system's printer. A dialog box will appear before printing is started to allow you to select the printer to be used and various other printer options. The **Ctrl+P** shortcut can be used for this command.

Tip Set your printer to the Landscape mode when printing Password Keeper documents.

# File Password

This command allows you to change the document access password for the file currently being edited. You will be prompted to enter the current document access password assigned to the file as well as the new password you wish to assign to it. You will be required to type the new password assignment a second time to verify the entry. This item will be disabled (grayed) if the current file has been modified and not saved yet, or the file was opened for viewing as read-only.

# **Options**

Opens the <u>Password Keeper Options</u> property sheet and allows you to change Password Keeper program settings. Use this command to configure the Password Keeper program.

# Exit

Closes the Password Keeper program and returns control to the Explorer desktop. The Ctrl+Q shortcut can be used for this

command.

 $\textbf{Tip} \ \text{Commonly used File commands can be invoked using } \underline{\text{shortcut keys}} \ \text{or buttons on the } \underline{\text{toolbar ribbon}}.$ 

# **Edit Menu**

# **Edit Menu Commands**

The Edit menu provides commands used to edit the contents of Password Keeper documents. A short description of each item follows:

# Copy Login Password

Copies the current account selection's password to the Clipboard. You can then paste this information into your login program. The **Ctrl+L** shortcut can be used for this command.

**Note** The Copy command will still copy the password to the Clipboard even if the <u>Display Password with Account</u> option is unchecked.

# Add Account

Use this command to <u>add</u> a new password account record to the current document. The **Ctrl+A** shortcut can be used for this command.

# **Edit Account**

Use this command to <u>edit</u> the currently selected password account record. You will be able to change the account name, login ID, password and notes specific to the currently selected record. The **Ctrl+E** shortcut can be used for this command.

# <u>D</u>elete

Deletes the currently selected account record. You will be prompted to confirm the record you wish to delete. The **Del** shortcut can be used for this command.

### Read Only

Turns editing permission on and off. If this item is checked the current document can be viewed but editing will not be allowed.

Tip Commonly used Edit commands can be invoked using shortcut keys or buttons on the toolbar ribbon.

# View Menu

# **View Menu Commands**

The View menu provides commands used to change Password Keeper display options. These items provide a means of changing the Password Keeper window appearance. A short description of each item follows:

### By Account

Check this item to display password account records sorted by account name. The **Alt+A** shortcut can be used for this command.

# By User Name

Check this item to display password account records sorted by user name. The **Alt+U** shortcut can be used for this command.

### By Password

Check this item to display password account records sorted by password. The **Alt+P** shortcut can be used for this command.

## Visit URL

Use this command to automatically launch your web browser and go the currently displayed account record's web site URL. The Ctrl+G shortcut can be used for this command.

Note If the current account record includes a password it will be copied to the Clipboard prior to launching your web browser.

# **Minimize**

Minimizes the Password Keeper window to a button or icon on the taskbar. The Ctrl+Y shortcut can be used for this command.

# Always on Top

Use this command to keep the Password Keeper window top most on the desktop. When this item is checked the Password Keeper window will float above all other non-topmost windows on the desktop. This item is useful if you normally run Password Keeper with a small window that would be easily obscured by other applications. The **Ctrl+T** shortcut can be used for this command.

# **Help Menu**

# **Help Menu Commands**

The Help menu provides commands used to get help with Password Keeper operations. A short description of each item follows:

#### Contents

Opens the Password Keeper Help window and displays the Table of Contents. The **F1** shortcut can be used for this command.

#### Search

Opens Password Keeper Help and displays the Search window. You can use this window to search for specific Password Keeper help topics.

# How to Use Help

Opens a Help window that explains how to use the MS Windows 95/NT Help program.

#### Register

Displays the Password Keeper <u>Shareware Registration Wizard</u>. This wizard allows you to register Password Keeper for Windows 95/NT for authorized use.

#### Setup

Displays the Password Keeper <u>Explorer Setup</u> property sheet. This window provides options to integrate Password Keeper with the MS Windows Explorer. Use this window to create MS Explorer Start Menu items and desktop icons.

# Web Site

Opens your web browser application and goes directly to the Software Design web site on the Internet.

# About Password Keeper

Displays the Password Keeper splash box. This window contains program information, the current version of Password Keeper you are running and a program copyright notice. Click the mouse anywhere in this window to close it

Tip Commonly used Help commands can be invoked using shortcut keys or buttons on the toolbar ribbon.

# **Toolbar Buttons**

# **Tool Ribbon Buttons**

Most commonly used Password Keeper menu commands can also be quickly invoked by pressing a button on the toolbar ribbon displayed at the top of the main window. These buttons work exactly the same way as the corresponding menu items that they duplicate.



New - Create a new document



Open - Open an existing document



Save - Save changes made to a document



Print - Print the current document



**Properties** - Show document properties



Copy - Copy the current password entry



Visit URL - Go to the current web site URL



Add - Add a new account record



Edit - Edit the current account record



Delete - Delete the current account record



Options - Open the Password Keeper Options property sheet



Help - Open this Help file



About - Show Password Keeper splash box

**Tip** If the Show ToolBar Tips option is selected a small popup tip window will appear when the mouse pointer is placed over a button. A short description of what each button does can be viewed using this method.

# **Shortcut Keys**

#### Shortcuts

Shortcut keys allow you to quickly invoke Password Keeper menu commands without first displaying the menu and then selecting an item from it. The most commonly used Password Keeper commands can be invoked using the following shortcut keys.

Ctrl+N Create a new Document
Ctrl+O Open an existing document

Alt+Enter Show properties for current document

Ctrl+W Close the current document
Ctrl+S Save changes made to the document

Ctrl+P Print the current document

Ctrl+Q Exit Password Keeper, and return to the desktop

 Add a new password account record

 Ctrl+E
 Edit the current account record

 Delete the current selection

View Menu

Alt+A Sort by Account

Ctrl+Y Minimize Password Keeper to a button or icon
Ctrl+T Make Password Keeper topmost on the desktop
