

Using the Movie Wizard

Q: What do you need to create a movie.

A: At the bare minimum you need two photographs.

If you choose "Do it for me" you will be prompted for two photographs and two company logos. You can substitute two bitmaps with your name or any other words on them.

To create these two bitmaps. Choose <File> <New> and select Netshow size. 176x144

Then merely choose The "T" button and add a line of text onto the center of the page. Save this file and make another.

When you select "Do it for me" you will load the two photographs and two bitmaps into the boxes there and press go.

The program will now take those two photographs and apply various processes to copies of them to create a short video.

The text you placed on the two bitmaps will be superimposed on the film.

Manual Use of the Wizard

First you must select a folder where your movie frames will be placed as they are made.

You can draw an image in main, then choose "Get image from main" then repeat the process and this will supply the necessary two images, or you can choose "Get image from file" and repeat.

Then select a process from the drop down box and press the button below the drop down list to apply the process.

Now load another image, then apply another process.

Continue in this way until you have the number of frames you would like.

Then press the button to show the movie.

You can get really creative by creating another series in a separate folder and superimposing that set on the first.

You do this with the effects button on the bottom.

The best way to figure out how this all works is to practice with two images adding a process and then loading another image.
