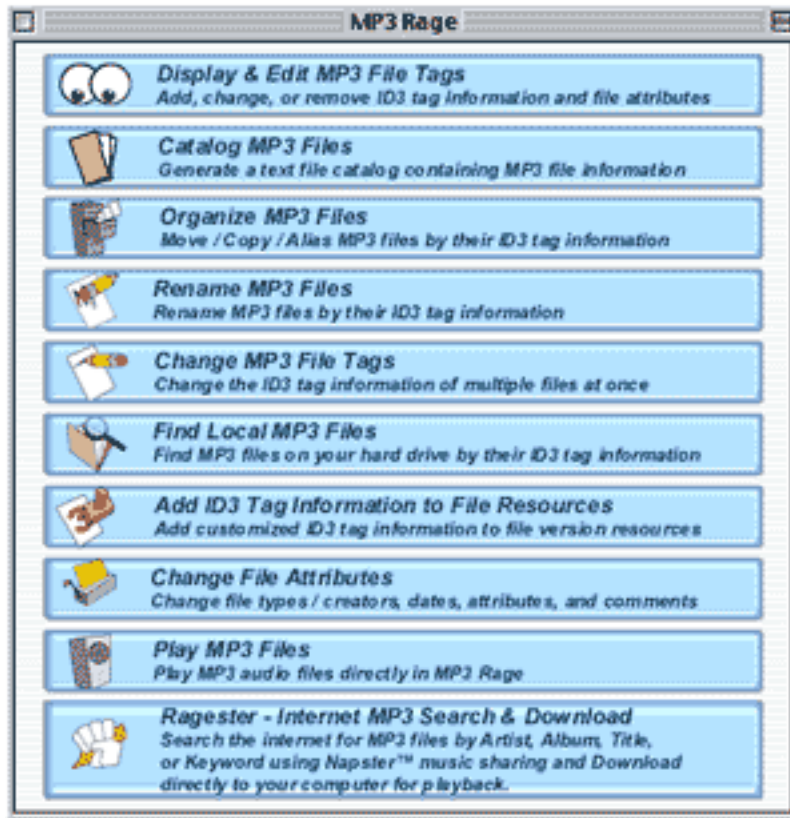


- 1) Song Title

Open MP3 Rage.

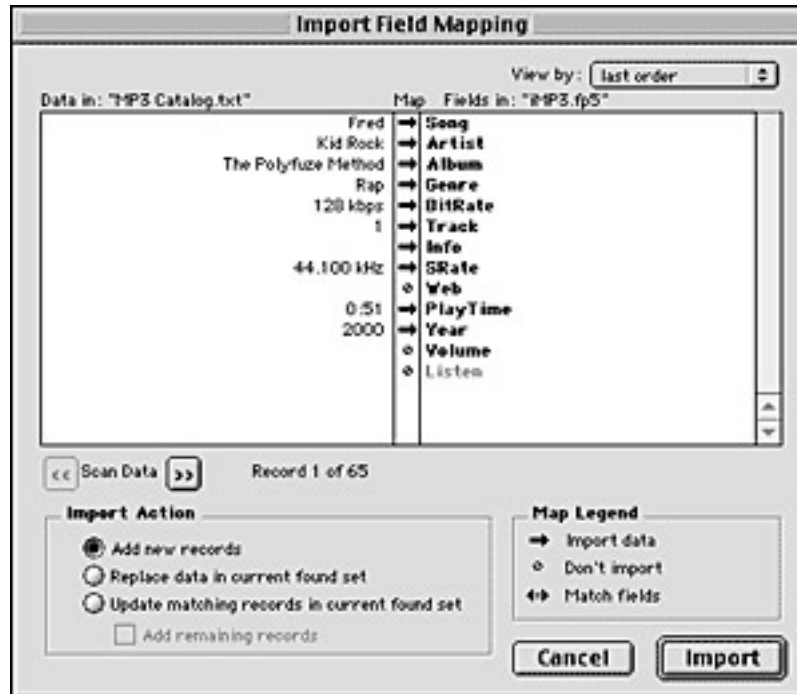
Click on Catalog MP3 Files.
