

Notes on the EazyDraw tutorials.

There is no planned reading order for these tutorials. They are designed to augment the primary Help documentation. They generally provide information on some of the more advance drawing concepts.

The files require that EazyDraw is installed. It is not possible to view them on a system without a working copy of EazyDraw.

The drawings are designed to be interactive, you should experiment and explore the content graphics while reading the explanations provided. It's a good idea to copy the entire folder then changes you make to the files will not effect the master originals that came with your installation disk.

You can even create new graphics and add notes to enhance these drawings for future reference.

And finally these examples can serve to showcase capabilities that might be interesting and that you may not have discovered through other methods.
