Welcome to EazyDraw

Please understand that by installing EazyDraw you are agreeing to the license agreement found on your CD or Disk Image.

Install EazyDraw by dragging and dropping the EazyDraw Icon from install CD or Disk Image to your location of choice. A common location is the Applications folder on you primary hard drive, but this is not required.

It is recommended that you review the ReadMe file for the latest information concerning this version.

Move the Examples and Tutorials folders from the install CD or Disk Image to your hard drive. The files in these folders may be viewed after the installation of EazyDraw is complete. The examples are interesting to see how different kinds of drawings may be constructed. The tutorial files combine live examples with text documentation, they are helpful for understanding how to work with some of the more advanced constructs such as technical drawing of dimensions, blends, patterns. These files are designed to be interactive, jump right in - make changes, experiment, explore, don't worry about your changes - you can always go back to the original.

Primary documentation is found under the Help Menu. This information is provided using the Apple Help technology. The information is heavily indexed and cross linked. The quickest way to an answer is usually a Search Phrase, enter your question in the text box provided at the top right of the Help window. Most parameter palettes have small question mark buttons - click them for a quick check of the documentation. Please give this a try, it is surprisingly helpful.

It is recommended that previous versions of EazyDraw be removed or overwritten during the installation. The operating system may keep using the older version when launched via a double click or an Icon on the system doc. If you wish to retain the older version we advise burning it to a CD or placing it in a stuffit archive.
