MPEG Streamclip Extras

This folder contains the QuickTime component "Save as AVI.component" that lets you edit AVI/DivX files in QuickTime Pro without reencoding them; and it also contains "Install Two DivX Versions", a script that lets you install two different versions of DivX in the same computer.

YOU DO NOT NEED TO INSTALL OR USE THESE TOOLS IF YOU DON'T PLAN TO MAKE A DIVX FILE.

Install Two DivX Versions

The new version 5.2.x of DivX has the MP2 decoder but not the DivX codec; the older version 5.1.1 has the DivX codec but not the MP2 decoder. So you may need to install both. With this script you can do it easily!

Suppose you have to install version 5.2.1 and 5.1.1. Run the installer of DivX 5.1.1 (or DivX Pro 5.1.1) first; then run "Install Two DivX Versions" once, then run the installer of DivX 5.2.1 (or DivX Pro 5.2.1).

To remove both version, first run "Install Two DivX Versions" <u>twice</u>, then run the uninstallers of both DivX versions. Keep this script in a safe place because you may need it to uninstall DivX completely.

This applescript is very simple: it just renames the component "DivX 5.component" (or "DivX Pro 5.component") in your /Library/QuickTime folder to "DivX 5 - 2nd.component" (or "DivX Pro 5 - 2nd.component") so the installer of the second version will not replace it but just adds another component.

When you run the script, it also trashes any already renamed DivX component eventually present in /Library/QuickTime, so if you run it twice, the script will remove both your "DivX 5.component" files. You still need to run the DivX uninstallers to remove the other installed files (like the DivX MP3 Encoder).

Of course, you can rename or trash the components by hand instead of using this script, if you prefer.

Save as AVI

With this powerful QuickTime component, you can open AVI/DivX files in QuickTime Pro, edit them with Cut/Copy/Paste/Clear, and save them back to AVI without reencoding video and audio (as it happens when you use the QuickTime AVI Exporter).
