This document includes information on the additional features of Version 2.2, not covered in the Help file, and how to register a copy of calvbx.vbx.

You can use the vbx for evaluation purposes and may redistribute the evaluation copy. However if you wish to continue using CalVBX you should register your copy of the calendar control. Once you've registered I will send you a fully operational copy of the calendar vbx.

Part 1: Additional Features of Ver 2.2

CalVBX is now Data aware and can be linked to any database field that is defined as a date/time field in the database. Once linked to a database and run CalVBX will display the date recorded in the Database field. Changing the date in CalVBX and moving to another record in the database will change the date in the Database to whatever was set in CalVBX.

Also Included in this version are the additional properties

Day Month Year

These give any easy way to change the date within your code.

Example: Calendar1.Year = 2003

If the Year value exceeds 2037 or below 1970 then Year is set to either 2037 or 1970.

Foreign language Support properties:

DaysOfWeek DateFormat

The DaysOfWeek and Months properties allow the displayed days or months to be customized for foreign language versions. Defaults to English, if customized the days or months must be seperated by | For example a Danish version may set DaysOfWeek as;

Calendar1.DaysOfWeek = "Ma|Ti|On|To|Fr|Lø|Sø"

The property DateFormat allows the displayed date to be formatted to any legal Visual Basic format string.

Calendar1.DateFormat = "mm/dd/yy 'Gives 10/04/95 Calendar1.DateFormat = "dd mmm yyyy" 'Gives 04 Oct 1995

On registration CalVBX is a royalty free control you can use bound to the following License agreement clause:

You have a royalty-free right to distribute only the "run-time modules" with the executable files created in any development tool if :

- (a) you distribute the "run time modules" only in conjunction with the executable files that make use of them as a part of your software product;
- (b) The SOFTWARE end users do not use the "run time modules" for development purposes. The "run time modules" are those files included in the SOFTWARE package that are required during execution of your software program.
