Getting Started

The License Utility is the application that allows you to view and update your Solution Studios product licenses. To use the utility, double-click on the "License Utility" icon in one of your Solution Studios program groups. (The executable file is sflicens\bin\luviewer.exe.)

View a License

To view a product license, select the product name from the list box. The <u>License Utility</u> will then read and display your software license for that product.


Update a License

To update a product license, press the "Update" button and complete the <u>Update Dialog</u>
<u>Box</u> that is displayed. You must include a license manager and license number to sucessfully update a license.

License Utility Reference

The License Utility is used to view and update your Solution Studios product licenses. The Viewer Dialog Box shown below is the window that is displayed when the License Viewer is started. To view a particular license, select the product from the product list box. The License Utility will then read and display the license.



<u>Product</u> - The Solution Studios product license that is currently being displayed.

Manager - The person that is responsible for managing the license.

Organization - The organization that is using the license.

Type - The type license installed:

Evaluation - Allows a complete evaluation of the software.

Developer - Allows for the develop of new applications.

Run Time - Allows a run time version of the product.

You should consult your license agreement for more detailed information for each license type.

License # - The license number that has been issued for this product license.

<u>Authzd Copies</u> - The number of concurrent copies that are allowed by this license.

<u>Days Remaining</u> - The number of days remaining if this is an evaluation license.

Update Dialog Box

The Update Dialog Box is used to update your product license. To use it, press the "Update" button on the main viewer window. You must provide at least a manager and License Number for the license to be updated successfully.



Manager - The person that is responsible for managing the license.

Organization - The organization that is using the license.

License # - The license number that Solution Studios has issued for this product license.
