Post-It! style sticky notepad.

## Introduction

WINotes is a Post-It! style notepad program for Windows 3.1+. WINotes is highly versatile - suitable for many uses, and is really user-friendly.

Instead of cluttering up your desktop, monitor, computer or whatever - you can clutter up Windows! You can have WINotes here, there and everywhere. If they decide to get in the way, just minimize them. Multiple WINotes can be run at once, each running independently and having its own characteristics and contents.

## Features

Here is a list of WINotes' major features:

- CLIPBOARD  
Basic text support (Cut, Paste etc.)
- USER CONFIGURABLE  
Change fonts, colours, size...
- ALARM REMINDER  
Fully configurable. See Alarms.
- WINDOW  
Always on top, five sizes, colours, title etc.
- ICON  
Intelligent icon, minimize to see...
- INSERT  
Date and time as note text or title.
- CAPACITY  
Notepad text capacity of 100 characters (32k registered).

# Operation

## Menus

<u>E</u> dit	▶
<u>I</u> nsert	▶
<u>P</u> roperties	▶

The main program menu can be accessed by right-clicking on the window, and each of the sub menus reached by running off the adjacent arrows.

The program can be quit by clicking **Exit** or using the system menu.

- Only some menu commands have keyboard shortcuts - the pop-up menu governs this; eg. COPY = CTRL+C.
- Or can be accessed using the underlined characters once on the main menu; eg. COPY = ALT+E, ALT+C.

This menu provides access to the Windows clipboard and text manipulation functions, enabling you to transfer text information between applications.

- Deletion of text can also be made by selecting it then hitting the delete key, as with other normal text box editing.

The date and time can be inserted into a WINote from here, in their long formats.  
eg. Date: 05/10/94, Time: 20:36:26

## Properties...



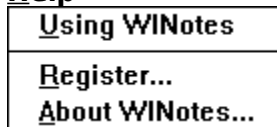
See [Alarms](#) for instructions on setting a reminder alarm.

The caption-bar title (WINotes by default) can be changed from here. This is useful if you want to give some indication as to the contents of the note.

Customisation also takes place here. The note's font, colour, size and general appearance can be altered easily.

- Always on top gives WINotes their "sticky" appearance. They stay where they are put, even when other applications are made active. This feature can be a bit of a pain, so you can just minimize the note!

### Help...

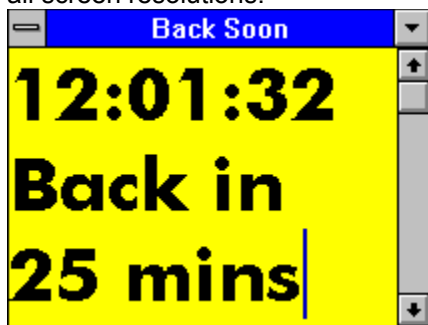


Access to the help file and About... box are found here.

When the registration menu is visible the registration code is entered here, unlocking the extra features of the program. This option is then made invisible.

### Note Variety

Notes can contain up to 32k of text (100 characters unregistered). They can be changed in appearance using the colour, fonts, size etc. menus. The size of the note determines the size of the display window. This is calculated according to actual screen dimensions, so the note window sizes should be the same in all screen resolutions.



### Example WINote Screen

Here we have a simple example note saying I've gone for one of my long lunch breaks!

Presentation has been kept fairly standard, with only the font style (Futura Md) and the note title (Back Soon) being changed. The time has been inserted (no watch needed) to give some relevance to the phrase 'back in 25 mins'.

### What To Do!

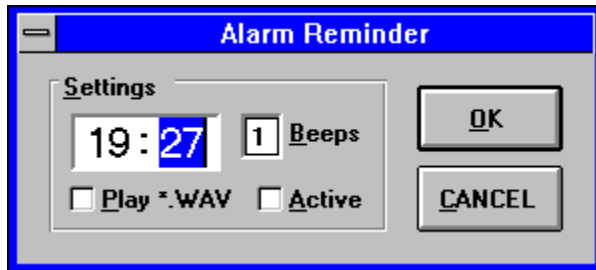

# Alarms

## Overview

This is one of the best features of WINotes, so we have given it its own section. The best way to learn how to use the alarm function is to experiment on your own. Even so, there is an example later on in this section, showing most features of the function.



The WINotes reminder alarm can be configured as follows:

- MULTIPLE CHIMES  
Any number of chimes from one to nine.
- PLAY WAVE AS BEEP  
Play any wave file as the beep - lots of possibilities. Registered version only.
- ANY TIME  
Any time, taken from Windows Control Panel, and the current day applies.

The WINotes window doesn't have to be the active application or even be visible for the note to take effect. It will pop up in front of all else. This process can be slow if the computer is already busy.

## Example Usage

The alarm reminder can be set up as follows:

- Choose the **Properties|Alarm** menu.
- Edit the time to the required hour and minute.
- Edit required number of beeps.  
Three is usually a good number, but a single beep will probably be a better choice for wave files.
- Choose a wave file if required. Windows comes with a few of its own.
- Activate the alarm.
- Press the OK button.

The title of the note will then be appended with the reminder time, and the note will ring at the appropriate time. If it is minimised or out of view then it will be brought to the front.
