

Bay, Bow and Box Windows

These large, dramatic windows serve as the focal point of a room. They project from the wall and emphasize the view, while brightening the space. Choose from fixed or operable windows, or a combination of both.

Bay windows have one or more center windows parallel with the wall, and angled side windows.

Bow windows are a series of narrow windows that form a gentle curve.

Box windows have squared-off sides. Greenhouse windows are a type of box window, usually with an aluminum frame, often installed over kitchen sinks.
