

Awning Windows

The clean lines of awning windows make them a good choice for contemporary houses. Typical arrangements include a stack of two or three awning windows, or a large fixed-pane window with a small awning window below for ventilation. Because the opening is small, awning windows offer extra security against break-ins.

These economical, operable windows swing open on hinges along their top edge. Those hinged along the bottom are called hopper windows. Some models swing outward, some swing inward. They are usually crank operated.
