What is Clocker?

Clocker is an event-scheduler. With it you can schedule events (run programs) at a certain time. This can be very useful for running backup programs, etc. It runs quietly in the background, functioning as a clock.

Getting Started

File Menu

Open...

Save...

Open...

Opens a stored Clocker data file. These files usually have a .CLK extension.

Files can also be opened via a command line option.

Save...

This option saves a Clocker data file for later use. The default extension is .CLK.

Settings Menu

Font

Add Item

Edit Item

Delete Item

Font

This option changes the screen font used for the time, both when running in a window and as an icon.

Note that if the font selected is too large, the time may not fit in the icon when the program is minimized.

Add Item

This option adds an item to the list of events. There are several fields:

Time

The time-of-day, in 24-hr time.

Date

The date of the event, in MM/DD/YY format. This date will also be used to calculate the day-of week for weekly events.

Command Line

This is the command line, exactly as it is to be executed. This can specify any executable file.

Frequency

This is the frequency with which the event is to occur - either once, daily, weekly, or monthly.

Delete Item

This option deletes the currently selected item from the list of events. If there is no selected item, this command will be ignored.

Command Line

The command line for Clocker is:

Clocker [clockerfile]

where clockerfile is a Clocker data file stored with the File Save... option.

License Info

Clocker is a shareware program. It is NOT free. If you use it, please register it.
