

## Intruder Alert

Intruder Alert allows you to lock your computer, much like a car alarm. When armed, it will be difficult for others to use your machine without making a lot of noise, unless they know the code.

Note: The code for Intruder Alert is initially 1 3 5 7 9. Make sure you remember it if you change it later!

### Arming Intruder Alert

To arm Intruder Alert, run it by double-clicking on its icon. Then, enter the code. The system will be locked until the code is entered again.

Note: Before Intruder Alert is fully armed, you can close it by clicking on the door handle.

### Unarming Intruder Alert

To unarm Intruder Alert, enter the correct code. Depending on the sensitivity of the alarm, you may need to use the keyboard instead of the mouse. You can still attempt to enter the correct code once the alarm is tripped.

Once Intruder Alert is unarmed, you can close it by clicking on the door handle.

### Configuring Intruder Alert

You can configure Intruder Alert when it is not armed. Click on the gas cap to configure Intruder Alert. You can choose three levels of sensitivity:

Low	The alarm is triggered if an incorrect code is entered
Med	The alarm is also triggered if the mouse is clicked
Hi	The alarm is also triggered if the mouse is moved!

You can also change the code (but you must know the current code!) and change the sound that is played when the alarm is tripped.

### Final Note

As with any software security product, Intruder Alert is not foolproof. At best, it will keep the honest people honest.
