

# Groupie

## Overview

Groupie is an add-on which adds some nifty features to Program Manager, such as the ability to change group icons and place groups within other groups.

## Changing Group Icons

Either Groupie itself or Iconplus (Our Icon changer) can be used to change group icons. Group icons will be displayed only when Groupie is loaded. When it is not loaded, default group icons will be displayed instead.

To change a group icon within Groupie, select the (minimized) group and select the Properties command from the File menu. There will be a button that allows the icon to be changed, just like with program items.

To use Iconplus, select the (minimized) group and select the Icon command from the File menu, just as with program items.

## Copying Groups Into Groups

Groups can be copied into other groups either by using the mouse or the File Copy command.

Using the mouse, hold down the control key, click on the (minimized) group, and drag it onto another (non-minimized) group. A copy of the group icon will be created.

Using the Copy command, select the (minimized) group and choose the Copy command from the File menu. Choose the group you want the icon copied to, and press OK.

Note that the group-in-group icons will work even if Groupie isn't loaded. Also note that although initially the group and its group-in-group icon may have the same icon, the two items are not linked.

## Making Groups Hidden

Hidden groups are useful when there are a lot of groups in Program Manager. Hidden groups do not leave an icon on the Program Manager desktop when minimized. They can, however, have an icon in another group, and will appear in the Group menu.

To mark a group as hidden, it must be restored and be the active group. Choose the Hide group item from the File menu to hide it. This item is a toggle.
