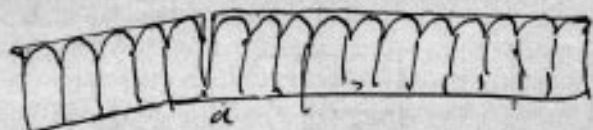


deceptive perspectives anywhere, but

when the subsidence stopped,
 they took the cornice off all,
 rebuilt the arch a, of junction,
 and threw the cornice up, to
 balance the fall by opposition.



This of cornice is a violent exaggeration
 - but the actual interval at b is
 about three feet. The work
