### 1.2 about

VMem is a virtual memory tool for all Amigas with Workbench 2.0 or higher. It provides a way for programs to use more memory than is actually available on your system. Unfortunately, it is impossible for VMem to force programs to use virtual memory on normal Amigas (that requires a special chip which is only present on amiga 3000s and 4000/040s, so they have to be specifically written to use it. However, by the time you read this, there could be lots of programs that use it. (You might even have received vmem with some program that uses it.)

## 1.3 instructions

This is the manual for the VMEM INSTALL PROGRAM. To run VMEM ←  
INSTALL,  
just double-click on it's icon, and you will be presented with a "welcome"  
message. Read this, and hit the "OK" gadget, and a requester will appear with  
the following options at the bottom:

Novice

Intermediate

Advanced

Programmers - Click Here First !!!

## 1.4 novice

NOVICE: Click this gadget if you don't know much about the AMIGA  
or you just want to get VMem going and aren't interested  
in special options. (Everything will be done  
automatically).

## 1.5 intermediate

INTERMEDIATE: Click this gadget if you know a bit about the AMIGA, and  
want a bit more control over which files will be installed,  
and where.

## 1.6 advanced

ADVANCED: Click this gadget if you know the amiga 'inside-out' and  
want total control over the installation procedure.  
(What files you want installed, and where each one will  
go).

## 1.7 programmers

NOTE TO PROGRAMMERS:

You must select INTERMEDIATE or ADVANCED if you want the option  
of installing the programming files.

(AUTODOCS:, INCLUDE:, and FD: should be assigned properly, although you  
can choose to select a different directory from within VMEM INSTALL.)
