Since the Reels are broadcast quality, which means they are 640x480 pixels in size and contain 30 frames per second, they can be output frame-by-frame to video. "We see a real need for broadcast-quality digital video for animators and video producers.", said Jonathan Gibson President of Form and Function. "With the new QuickTime editors you can do so much to manipulate digital video. WraptureReels provides a source of broadcast-quality digital video that can be used with these new editors and then put back out to video tape with excellent results.", he continued.

Another main feature of the WraptureReels is that they loop seamlessly which means they can play indefinitely with no detectable start or stop points. "The looping feature will be of great use to 3D animators who are interested in mapping QuickTime movies to objects.", remarked Gibson. "Many of the animated textures on the disc can be used to map to words and objects to create an M-tv -style effect."

An electronic HyperCard 2.1 browser is included on the disc that allows the user to peruse and view the WraptureReels as well as copy them to the users hard drive.

WraptureReels makes full use of System 7.0 features by providing a color picon (picture - icon) of each WraptureReel file. An "Aliases Folder" that holds aliases for each of the WraptureReels is also included on the

disc. Users can move this folder to their own hard drive for quick access

to the files on the Disc. All Form & Function discs contain On-Location™

file indexes as well.

The disc also includes the QuickTime 1.0 system extension needed to

view the QuickTime movies; HyperCard 2.1 needed to run the electronic

browser; and PopCorn[™], the QuickTime player from Aladdin Systems.
