

SpiderPad - Read Me for v1.1.0

This help file contains last-minute documentation changes and version-specific notes.

Upgrading from 1.0

SpiderPad uses a new format for saving toolbar buttons and shortcuts. SpiderPad should convert your old toolbar buttons to the new format, but you will have to reenter your shortcuts.

Status Bar Buttons

The status bar document buttons have been temporarily removed while we investigate reports of file corruption problems.

Browser Support

SpiderPad supports tags and attributes for Netscape Navigator 2.0 and Microsoft Internet Explorer 3. You may select which attributes to enable in the Preferences dialog. Note, however, that the two browsers are in conflict in some cases (the Table builder is a good example), so SpiderPad compromises. Please consult HTML documentation for more information on browser support.

Browser Preview works best with Netscape.

Troubleshooting

If you are using "Save preferences into document" and your browser refuses to read your document, either add a closing "</spiderpad>" tag or move the "<spiderpad>" tag to the bottom of the document.

Users have reported problems when using VGA adapters (as opposed to Super VGA adapters). As soon as a fix is found it will be posted to our web site http://www.sixlegs.com/>.

Clipboard operations, undo, and some other features are limited to 32K byte selections.

Rare coloring problems--Choosing Recolor from the Edit menu should fix the problem. If no text is selected it will recolor the current paragraph (as defined by carriage returns). To properly recolor multi-line tags you should select the tag before choosing recolor.

SpiderPad does not automatically recolor your documents after you change the color preferences. Choose Recolor Document from the Edit menu.
