### Minimum system requirements for QuarkXPress 4.0 for 68K Mac OS

- 68020 or greater processor
  - System 7.1 or later (Open Transport 1.1 or greater recommended)
  - 5 MB of free RAM (7 MB or greater recommended for graphic-intensive documents)
  - 12 MB of free hard disk space for full installation
  - Adobe Type Manager 3.8.2 or above recommended
- 

### Minimum system requirements for QuarkXPress 4.0 for PowerPC Mac OS

- PowerPC processor
  - System 7.1.2 or later
  - 8 MB of free RAM (10 MB or greater recommended for graphic-intensive documents)
  - 14 MB of free hard disk space for full installation
  - Adobe Type Manager 3.8.2 or above recommended

### Minimum system requirements for QuarkXPress 4.0 for Windows

- 486 or greater processor

- Windows 95, Windows NT 4.0, or Windows NT 3.51
  - 12 MB of RAM (additional memory may be required for graphic-intensive documents)
  - 12 MB of free hard disk space for full installation
  - VGA or higher resolution display adapter and monitor supported by Windows 95 or Windows NT
  - Adobe Type Manager 3.0 or above recommended (required to view and print Type 1 fonts)

### **Installing QuarkXPress 4.0 for Mac OS**

1. Download the QuarkXPress application and associated files.
2. Decompress the files, then place them in a new folder on your hard drive.
3. Place any XTensions software in a folder called XTension.
4. Install the hardware key.
5. Double-click the QuarkXPress 4.0 icon within this folder to launch the application.

The Quark CMS and POCE XTensions software require that certain files be placed in the System folder. To install these files, open the Items for System Folder folder from the downloaded archive. Copy the files to the folders mentioned in the folder names (for example, the files in the Include at Root Level of System folder should be placed loose in your System folder). When you launch QuarkXPress 4.0, you must activate CMS to gain access to its features by checking Color Management Active in the Color Management Preferences dialog box (Edit -> Preferences -> Color Management).

### **Installing QuarkXPress 4.0 for Windows**

1. Download the QuarkXPress application and associated files.
2. Decompress the files, then place them in a new folder on your hard drive.
3. Place any XTensions software in a folder called XTension.
4. Install the hardware key.
5. Double-click the QuarkXPress.exe icon within this folder to launch the application.

To use the ICC Color Profiles with the Quark CMS XTensions software, copy the profiles to the Windows/System/Color folder. When you launch QuarkXPress 4.0, you must activate CMS to gain access to its features by clicking Color Management Active in the Color Management Preferences dialog box (Edit -> Preferences -> Color Management).

Note: Although QuarkXPress 4.0 will run under Windows NT 3.51, some file names may become truncated after unzipping the downloaded archive. These files should still function properly.

### **Known problems with QuarkXPress 4.0 Final Candidate #1 for Mac OS**

- There are some known problems when running NowMenus with QuarkXPress 4.0.
- Closing QuarkXPress while the Lists palette and a Book are open may cause the application to crash.
- Text on a Path that is greeked may not display properly.
- Changing the Noise and Smoothness values of certain graphics containing Alpha Channels may cause the application to crash.
- Pressing Command+Option+F to close the Find/Change palette may cause the application to crash.
- Applying a pattern to a line, then attempting to make it solid again may cause the line to keep the previous style applied.

- Linking arrows may continue to display after linking text paths.
- Appending style sheets with keyboard equivalents assigned may result in multiple style sheets using the same keyboard equivalents within one document.
- Entering XP and YP coordinates in the Measurements palette when working with a rotated Bézier box may cause incorrect movement of the box.
- Selecting More Information in the Usage dialog box may add an OK button that isn't useable.
- Saving a 4.0 document containing text paths in 3.3 format may cause reflow when opened in 3.3x.
- Checking Outside Edges Only in the Clipping tab of the Modify dialog box while Invert is checked may cause incorrect clipping to display.

Note: Files saved in this beta version may not open in future beta versions, or in the shipping product. Make copies of your existing documents before opening them in this beta copy of QuarkXPress 4.0.

### **Known problems with QuarkXPress 4.0 Final Candidate #1 for Windows 95/NT**

- Closing QuarkXPress while the Lists palette and a Book are open may cause an application error.
- Text on a Path that is greeked may not display properly.
- Pressing Ctrl+Alt+F to close the Find/Change palette may cause an application error.
- Applying a pattern to a line, then attempting to make it solid again may cause the line to keep the previous style applied.
- Dragging an item from a library to a document when the library is too far away from the application window may cause an application error.
- Linking arrows may continue to display after linking text paths.
- Cancelling out of an Append conflict may cause an application error.
- Appending style sheets with keyboard equivalents assigned may result in multiple style sheets using the same keyboard equivalents within one document.
- Entering XP and YP coordinates in the Measurements palette when working with a rotated Bézier box may cause incorrect movement of the box.
- Selecting More Information in the Usage dialog box may add an OK button that isn't useable.
- Opening certain 3.3x documents containing WMF graphic files may cause an application error.
- Dragging and dropping a QuarkXPress document into the application while text is selected may cause an application error.
- Dragging Bézier shapes between files may cause an application error.
- Saving a 4.0 document containing text paths in 3.3 format may cause reflow when opened in 3.3x.
- Closing a document with the Find/Change palette open may cause an application error.
- Resizing a box multiple times while holding down Ctrl+Alt+Shift may cause an application error.
- Checking Outside Edges Only in the Clipping tab of the Modify dialog box while Invert is checked may cause incorrect clipping to display.

Note: Files saved in this beta version may not open in future beta versions, or the shipping product. Make copies of your existing documents before opening them in this beta copy of QuarkXPress 4.0.
