### INTRODUCTION:

What is WagVision? WagVision was created with Objectvision... a front end for Paradox, dBase, BTrieve, and some other database formats for Windows! So, as you may have already guessed, ObjectVision is merely window dressing. WagVision's goal is to find useful situations for ObjectVision and distribute them for a minimal price to the general public.

WagVision is a nice way to store useful, necessary, and important information in a user friendly environment. WagVision has provided the means. It is up to you to unlock it's potential and make it work for you. If you're not using WagVision you're not seeing 20/20. Stop computing in the dark, get some vision, WagVision.

# INSTALLATION:

If you've never installed a Windows application before in your life please read the following section. If you have installed Windows applications in the past, go ahead, jump right in. I do assume a minimal level of knowledge about DOS and Windows. You should be able to create directories, move files, run Windows and decompress archives. If you're clueless about these things please refer to your DOS, or Windows reference for help.

Now that I have scared you sufficiently, the installation process is really very simple. The following procedure needs to be follows to setup WagVision, ObjectVision Runtime, and MusicVision.

- 1. Place the ObjectVision Runtime files into a work directory.
- Enter Windows by typing WIN at the DOS prompt.
- 3. From the Program Manager select FILE.
- From the drop-down menu select RUN...
- 5. Enter the following on the Command Line:

#### C:\WORK\INSTALL.EXE

- 6. Hit return or click the OK button.
- 7. The installation process should begin in a few seconds. An ObjectVision Runtime icon should appear behind your Program Manager screen. You will be given the opportunity to specify the directory for ObjectVision Runtime, the default path is C:\VISIONR and the process will begin.

Unarchive all the MusicVision files into the sample directory. To install MusicVision make sure the ObjectVision group, or whatever group you are using, is active and follow the following procedures:

- 1. Select File from the Program Manager menu bar.
- 2. From the drop-down menu select NEW.
- 3. Select PROGRAM ITEM from the pop-up menu and select OK.
- 4. In the Program Item Properties menu enter the following information:

DESCRIPTION: MusicVision

COMMAND LINE: C:\VISIONR\VISION.EXE C:\VISIONR\SAMPLE\CDBASE.OVD

WORKING DIRECTORY: C:\VISIONR

SHORT-CUT KEY: [NONE]

Enter OK after all the information is entered.

**NOTE WELL:** To load MusicVision automatically the Command Line must include the VISION executable and the OVD file you wish to boot automatically. The VISION executable also has several icons imbedded into the program. To enter MusicVision, all that is necessary is to double click the icon.

## What Do All The Neat Buttons Do?

Bottom: Repositions the database to the last record.

Clear: Wipes all the fields in preparation for writing a new record.

Delete: Removed a record currently displayed. ObjectVision is unable to display a

record which has been deleted or marked for deletion.

Exit Lookup: Return to the MAIN.

Exit Songs: Return to the MAIN.

List All: This function will show all the artist's and their albums in your database.

List Songs: Enters the SONGS portion of the database. From here you can list the songs on

the album.

Insert: Writes associated ObjetcVision field values to a new record.

Next: Reads the next record in the database.

Previous: Reads the record just before the current database record.

Quit: Exit MusicVision.

View: Select the Group/Artist or the Album Title by double clicking your choice then

click the VIEW button.

Store: Uses the current data either to insert a new record into the database file, or, if

the record is being viewed, to update the current record.

Top: Repositions the databse to the first record.

Update: Writes current data values to the currently viewed record of the database.

## Registering:

You can call The Harvest BBS and download your own registered copy of MusicVision.
