SYSTEM REQUIREMENTS

Operating System

Your computer must have Microsoft Windows 95 or higher versions of this operating system.

Disk Space

This program requires approximately 60 megabytes of space on your hard drive.

A 3D video accelerator card is strongly recommended.

Hardware



A mouse or pointing device is required. Many games are joystick compatible.



In order to hear sounds you must have a sound card and speakers.

A SoundBlaster[™] compatible sound card is recommended.

To access our web site you must have a modem and a connection to the Internet.

INSTALLATION

CD Installation

Using Windows 95 or Higher Versions

- 1. Place the CD into your CD-ROM drive.
- In the start-up screen click on START, then click on RUN. 2.
- Type in D:\CDSETUP and press Enter. (If your CD-ROM drive is not D, 3. change it to the letter associated with your CD-ROM drive.)
- 4. Follow any instructions that appear on the screen.

STARTING THE PROGRAM

Navigate to the program's folder and double-click on its icon. You may also find the program's icon by clicking on the Start button, selecting the "Programs" group, and looking for the program icon. If you are not familiar with how to find

and run programs on your computer, please consult your WindowsTM 95/98 instruction manual.



SETUP

Before running the game, make sure you run the Display Setup program first and that the correct video mode was selected. The installation program should automatically launch Display Setup for you. If you aborted this setup program, selected the wrong video card, or need to change your video mode, simply rerun Display Setup again from inside the game's folder.

IMPORTANT: If you don't have a 3D video card, you should always choose 'Software Mode' and run the game in low-resolution mode with all the options turned off.



If you have purchased the multi-language version of this game, English, French, and Spanish (and possibly additional languages) can be chosen while the program is running. Hit the 'Alt' key to get the mouse cursor, and select the 'Game' pull-down menu. Choose the 'Language' option, and then choose 'English, Francais, or Espanol.'

GETTING STARTED

Game Menus

During the demo mode, hit any key, or move the mouse or joystick to bring up the menu. To hide the menu, either wait awhile, or hit any key. When a menu item is highlighted, hit the spacebar to select that item, or hit the appropriate fire button on your mouse or joystick. While a game is in progress, you can bring up the menu at any time by hitting the 'Esc' key on your keyboard. The 'Play' option will now be a 'Quit Game' option, which allows you to abort a game.



Starting a Game

To start, choose either 'Play' or 'Load Game' from the main menu with the arrow keys, mouse, or joystick. Next, select this item by pressing the spacebar on your keyboard, the mouse, or joystick button.

Game Play

Move to a different slot machine by hitting the 'Change Machine' button in the upper left-hand corner of the screen, or choose 'Select Machine' from the main menu. IMPORTANT: You will need to accumulate enough cash to move on to the more expensive machines. In other words, you cannot select a \$50 machine if you have less than \$50 in your pocket.



After pressing the 'Change Machine' button or selecting 'Select Machine' from the main menu, the 'Select a Machine' menu will appear. Choose the betting price and the machine type NOTE: Not every machine type is available for every betting price... you will have to win more cash and work your way up in order to see all the different machines. When the desired machine has been selected, choose 'Confirm Change' to move to the new machine.



Save the game by choosing 'Save Game' from the main menu. You may bring up the main menu by hitting the 'Esc' key. Next, select the slot number where you want to save the game. Move the cursor over the slot and hit the spacebar or mouse button. This game can be loaded anytime a game is not in progress by choosing 'Load Game' from the main menu.
