## **About Geography USA**

Geography USA was first written in Dutch in 1993 and part of a collection of geography programs of Van Dorp Educatieve Programmatuur.

In 1995 Eric J. van Dorp, owner of VDEP, translated the program to English. In this version the program was still named Topography USA. With the help of the first users some language and data errors were corrected. Also the name was changed to Geography USA which is probably a more appropriate name for the program. Geography USA is distributed worldwide as shareware. Don't forget to register when you decide to continue using the program.

In 1995 more VDEP programs will be translated to an English version. Among these programs will be World Distance (to calculate distances around the globe), Geography Africa (equal to Geography USA) and World Climate (a visual climate database). Software distributors with interest in one or more of these programs are encouraged to contact the author.

## **How to use the study mode ?**

When starting the program you automatically come in the study mode. In this mode you can learn all names, capitals and locations of all states by clicking either on the name of the state in the listbox or on the state itself at the map.

At the status line, below the map, the capital of the state is named.

To study the 50 cities click on the 'cities'-button to get the names of the cities listed, or click on the small yellow circle indicating the location of the city.

You can study this way as long as you like. When you want to test your knowledge simply click at the 'test'-button.

## **How to test your geography knowledge ?**

You can easily test your knowledge by clicking on the 'test'-button. But before you do this make sure that the 'testoptions' is set in the way you want. You can choose one of the following options:

- find correct name of state or city
- locate city or state at the map
- name state by capital
- name capital by state

The last two options will show you a special testform.

Whether you are tested for states or cities depends if the listbox is currently filled with names of cities or states. To change between these two click the 'states/cities'-button.

You can end a test half way by clicking at the 'stop'-button or End.

At the end of a test you are shown your final score and asked for your name. These will be stored on disk and can be shown by clicking on 'testresults'.

## **How to register ?**

This program is shareware. This means that you can try the program for two weeks. After this trial period you must either register or remove the program from your computer.

To register simply send 15 US dollars (or an equivalent in your own currency) as a common used bankcheque or banknote to the author.

After registering you will receive a copy without any nagscreens.
