


## Try it out!

**Add border:** Click to the left of any of the blue section titles. Select Border from the Format menu. Click the Box button under Preset Borders and select 50% in the Shading box. Click OK.

**Multiple columns:** Click the  button on the ribbon.

**Modify drawing:** Double-click the map. Click and drag the word "Parking" to another location. Click the Close box.

**Change style:** Position the I-beam anyplace in the body. Select Special from the style box on the ribbon.

**Voice annotation:** Select Voice Annotations from the View menu. Click Play. At the end, click the Cancel button.

On Thursday, March 18, 100 sixth graders from Madison Middle School planted native willows and shrubs on the section of Green Creek which runs by Highway 99.

Teachers Ron Thurston and Sid Young organized the project with help from the County Office of Environmental Programs. The Madison Future

Farmers of America prepared the site before planting to help ensure the new vegetation will succeed.

Native trees and shrubs growing along a streambank enhance fish and wildlife by providing food and shelter, and preventing erosion.
