

# TeleFinder vs. FirstClass

I would assume that this has to do with the fact that I set up both the TeleFinder and FirstClass SIG's (Special Interest Groups) on AOL, or the simple fact that I run both systems from my home on the same computer.

I would like to start out by stating that the contents of this document are conclusions on my part and therefore are subject to all of my biases, inconsistencies and personal experiences. I will however try to remain within the realm of reality as I report on the above two programs.
