## 1.3 ADOS V2.5 Documentation

To load AmigaDOS Guide V2.5 you will need an Amiga running Workbench 2.0 or greater.

To then run AmigaDOS Guide V2.5 simple double click on the ADOS V2.5 icon.

Please Note:

This version of the software has not been designed to run from Hard Drive and can only be executed from Floppy disk.

Using AmigaDOS Guide V2.5

Because AmigaDOS Guide uses a Point and Click system it is very easy to use. So I will not bother trying to explain it all. Also this version includes Online documentation which explains everything you need to know.

AmigaDOS Guide has been split into 5 separate subjects, these are:

- ADOS Commands
- ADOS Applications
- ADOS Errors
- Workbench 3 Progs
- Amiga Glossary

When you click on your chosen subject you will find a file requester filled with names relating to that subject. From there you can then click on whatever it is you are looking for.

Misc

Within the ADOS Commands and ADOS Applications you will see a button called "ADOS Shell". This button will allow you to open a Shell

terminal. To get at it you will need to click on the Multi-tasking gadget at the top right hand corner of the screen. Alternatively you can Iconify the Interface by clicking on the small Blank Box in the top left corner of the screen.

On the Main Menu you will notice a button called "Additional Info". This as the name suggests will provide you with additional information on devices etc. Which may be of some use when using certain Commands etc.

To Quit out of AmigaDOS Guide V2.5 simply goto the menu bar at the top and press the Right mouse button then select quit.
