- Workbench 3.5 or 3.9 (Kickstart 3.1 ROMs)
- icon.library (V44.x)
- DIROpus Magelan (for NewIcons the V5.82 patch is required!)
- or other startmenu-tool like screentab
- an average high screen resolution  $\geq 800 \times 600$  (square)
