His cinematography credits also include *The Big Kahuna*, starring Kevin Spacey and Danny DeVito, and *Keeping the Faith*, actor Edward Norton's directing debut, starring Norton and Ben Stiller. TASS is currently on location filming *Death to Smoochy*, starring Robin Williams, bringing him together for a third collaboration with Norton and DeVito.
