Our programmms are made with the powerfull Blitz Basic 2 by Acid Software. Our second goal is to make Blitz wellknown (mainly in France), because it is probably one of the best languages.

Life Team programmms :

W-Anim : an IFF anim in window viewer. It has lots of functions (frame rate, palette choose ...).

Insulte : a program that insults you (french only at the moment :-() !!!

LTAssign : an AppIcon that assigns files you drop on it.

Searcher : a powerfull file finder with a superb GUI.

SmallGrabber : a screen grabber with another superb GUI ;-)

IRT : Icon Replacement Tool, a useful tool to change icons.

AppSize : An AppIcon that tels you the size of the directory you launch on it.
