### 1.2 what\_is\_it

Ever found it a pain doing a cleanup on workbench and then having to move all the icons you've left out back to their original places ?

Well TouchIco adds an easy way of repositioning any icons left out.

When run it adds an option to the WB tools menu called "Touch Icons" when selected it touches all the icons that have been left out, this causes WB to put them back where they were.

### 1.3 usage

TouchIco only has one parameter which is set using the DRIVES= ↵  
tootype.

It works by scanning the .backdrop files on the drives you specify and touching all of these icons to force WB to move them back to where they were snapshot'd.

---

To scan DH0 & DH1 the tooltype line would be as follows :-

```
DRIVES=DH0|DH1
```

You could also use volume names etc:-

```
DRIVES=Workbench|Work
```

When run once TouchIco adds a "Touch Icons" entry to the WB Tools menu.

When run again TouchIco unloads it's self.
