If you receive a message indicating that the "page cannot be found" then it is possible that the information, or updated information, is available on the site, but the html page has a different name. Try going to the homepage of the web site and looking for an index. For example, if you link to:
example.com/apples

and get a message indicating that the page is not found, try example.com and looking for an index.
