Overview

Q7 Utilities is a set of five small Windows utilities that can each be turned on or off using the check boxes. The Q7 Utilities window has five buttons: Hide, Quit, Help, About, and Close. The Hide button will hide the window. To view the window again, start Q7 Utilities a second time. Starting Q7 Utilities with a command-line argument (ex. q7utils.exe /x) will initially hide the window. The Quit button will unload Q7 Utilities, the Help button will load Q7UTILS.HLP, this help file, and the About button will display the copyright and registration information. The Close button will minimize the Q7 Utilities window.

RightClose

RightClose enables you to close a window by clicking the secondary mouse button in the window's control menu box. As of version 1.0, RightClose does not work with maximized child (document) windows.

ReStart

ReStart adds a "Restart Windows" item to the Program Manager's File menu. Selecting this item will restart Windows, after checking with all running applications.

RightMax

RightMax enables you to maximize or restore a window by clicking the secondary mouse button anywhere in the window's title bar.

RightMin

RightMin enables you to minimize a window that has been maximized by clicking the secondary mouse button in the extreme upper right corner of the screen, in the window's restore box.

RightScroll

RightScroll enables you to position a scroll box quickly by clicking and dragging the secondary mouse button anywhere in the scroll bar.
