
WillNotes 2.1 Help File

Registration Information




Simply *left click* on the area of the program in question to obtain help with WillNotes. If you would like, click here to find ordering information.

WillNotes is a simple Post-It style application with a lot of good sense. The pad itself holds up to as many notes as you need, simply click on the <u>add button</u> to add a note to the end of the pad. Use the up and down arrows to scroll through your notes. Remember to add at least one note to the pad if you intend to save and to hit the up or down arrow. the way this works is that WillNotes commits the note to memory only if you scroll to another note (otherwise it is on the screen right, why bother to remember it?). You must save in order to allow you notes to be used in another session.

A handy feature is <u>TackUp</u>. This launches a stand alone executable (tackup.exe) to be a small note in the corner. TackUp has no disk saving ability of its own and is intended solely as a supplement to WillNotes.

Right clicking on the title bar allows you to change the title of WillNotes to reflect the content of your note. As long as you follow the suggestions above, the new title will be saved with the body of the note.

The TackUp Feature



The TackUp works through the clipboard to give you a quick representation of a note that can be easily placed on the screen. You can edit and type directly into this note, but there is no provision for saving it. You can also select a custom color by *right clicking* on the bottom of the note. To remove the note from the screen *left click* on the upturned corner.

The Edit Menu Commands

The Edit Menu allows you access to the standard cut, copy, paste, delete, and undo functions that you are used to, as well as two others.

Insert Date

This puts the current date at the cursor location, a very handy feature for people who can never seem to remember what day it is.

Insert Time

This puts the current system time into the note, at the location of the cursor.

The File Menu Commands

The file menu contains all of the standard commands for file access. Please remember to save your files if you intend to ever use them again. If you forget there is no way to correct the problem.

The View Menu Commands

The view menu controls the user interface of WillNotes through the following commands:

ToolBar

This toggles the ToolBar either on or off.

Status Bar

This toggles the status line at the bottom of the program on or off.

Add Page

WillNotes acts as a multipage pad with the number of pages configurable by the user. Initially the pad is only one page, the root page. In order to have more than one note in a file you must add a new page, either with the menu command or the ToolBar button. Currently the number of pages is limited to a theoretical maximum of 32,000. I don't think anyone will need that many.

Remove Page

This removes the current page from the pad and moves back one page as a result. You cannot delete the first (root) page.

Increment

This moves forward in the pad one page. If there are no further pages, the command is dimmed.

Decrement

This moves backward in the pad one page. If there are no prior pages, the command is dimmed.

TackUp

This implements the <u>TackUp</u> command.

The Help Menu Commands

The help menu controls access to this help file, as well as giving you access to the about box.

Left clicking the tear corner rips the note from the screen, removing it from memory.

Right clicking in this area exposes the color dialog. This allows you to set the TackUp's color.

This invokes the add command. See the <u>View Menu</u> for details.

This invokes the remove command. See the <u>View Menu</u> for details.

This invokes the decrement command. See the <u>View Menu</u> for details.

This invokes the increment command. See the <u>View Menu</u> for details.

Right clicking on the title bar allows you to set the title of the note. This is saved with the file.

Registering WillNotes

If you find WillNotes useful, you are expected to register within 30 days. It takes a lot of time to create software, as well as money. Without registration, shareware cannot continue.

WillNotes is free of nags and is provided as is without any warranty express or implied. WillNotes is copyright ©1994 Will Ballard.

Registered users will receive a disk with the latest version of WillNotes and other shareware offers via mail upon receipt of payment. The next version of WillNotes is slated to incorporate new OLE 2 technology and support the Windows 4.0 component object model. Registered users will be entitled to a free upgrade.

Other projects in the works at include WillDesk, a global menu and ToolBar program that acts as a shell supplement, PhoneBar 2.1, which will include printing support for the first time, and Diary 2.0, an object linking scrapbook to hold important photos and memoirs.
