The icons in this collection are all made up of two icons that fit perfectly together. The reason for this is because you can then get much more detailed icons, due to their larger size, on your desktop. To get your icons to line up you will need to turn off the "snap to grid" in your views control panel. If you don't want to do that each time you want to move the icons, then simply hold down the command key when dragging them. This will temporarily disable the "snap to grid" function. You can use the top icon and the bottom icon for storing your stuff as per normal folders (I find that the bottom icon is best for me).

've noticed over the years a sad lack of Australian Shareware on the net and BB's that I inhabit and so, I've endeavoured to find a solution, hence "Icons For Your Wife", "Icons of Your Wife", "More Icons For Your Wife" and "Swimsuits For Your Wife". If you've ever wanted to pay the shareware fee for a program that you've downloaded, then here's a chance to expunge your guilt.
