Playing the Game To play, bet from one to three coins and then click on pull.

Game Menu Commands

<u>· New Game</u> <u>· High Scores...</u> <u>· Reset Scores</u> <u>· Remove Player</u> <u>· Exit</u>

New Game A new game may be started by pressing F2. If a game is currently active and new game is chosen, the current player will be cashed out before the new player is entered.

High Scores... Display the top 10 money winners. Your name will be added to the high score list if you exceed your highest previous score. (See also reset scores)

Reset Scores Removes all player scores from the high score list.

Remove Player Removes the history of the current player from the game system. This is especially useful when all of a player's money has been lost.

Exit The player may exit the game by pressing Alt+F4 or from within the Game menu by clicking on exit or hitting x. Any credits are added to the player's purse and stored for later use.



Bet! Command This command wagers 1 coin in the pot each time it is clicked with 3 coins being the maximum.



Pull! Command Spins the reels on the slot machine.

## **Options Menu Commands**



Chip Denomination Command The checked number represents the dollar denomination of each coin. These numbers range from \$1 to \$10,000. The denomination may be changed at the start of any round.

Bet Maximum Command Implementing this option permits the player to bet the maximum number of coins with one click of the bet button.

Automatic Pull Command This option permits the player to choose the maximum number of bets required before the system automatically pulls the handle. This option can be disabled by choosing 0 and can not be greater than five - the maximum number of bets allowed.

Sound Command Checking this option turns the sound on. Using the Keyboard
