#### **Overview**

Comic Chat is a comic-strip version of Internet Chat. You can connect to a chat room on an Internet server and conduct real-time conversations with other people. You can pick a cartoon character to represent you, and your conversation appears as word balloons in frames of a comic strip. With Comic Chat, you can express a wide range of emotions, send "thoughts," and save the chat session for offline viewing.

The Comic Chat window is composed of the following parts:

- A "Starring" pane, which prints the title of the chat and lists the participants
- The member list pane
- The viewing pane, where conversation occurs and chat history appears as a comic strip
- A self-view pane, which shows what your character looks like
- The emotion wheel
- A compose pane, where you type your messages

#### To connect to a server or chat room

- 1 On the File menu, click New.
- 2 Click Expand, and then type the name of the server you want to connect to—for example, comicsrv1.microsoft.com.
- 3 Type your TCP/IP port number for the <u>IRC</u> connection. The default number is 6667.
- 4 Type the name of a chat room on a server, beginning with a number symbol (#). If you type a name that does not exist, a new one is created with that name.
- 5 Type your full name.

#### To connect to a favorite chat room

• On the Favorites menu, click Open Favorites, and then click the room that you want. You keep the same character from your most recent chat session.

## To add a chat room to your Favorites

While in the chat room, click the Favorites menu, and then click Add To Favorites.

## Tip

Comic Chat adds a shortcut to this chat room to your Favorites folder.

#### To change a server or rooms

- 1 On the File menu, click New.
  - If you want a new nickname, type it in the Nickname box.
  - If you want a new character, select one from the Character list.
- 2 Click Expand, and then type the name of the new server you want to connect to—for example, comicsrv1.microsoft.com.
- 3 In the Channel box, type the name of a chat room, beginning with a number symbol (#). If you type a name that does not exist, a new one is created with that name.

#### To search for a specific chat room

- 1 On the View menu, click Chat Room List.
- 2 In the Display Chat Rooms Which Contain box, specify the type of chat room you want to enter. If you want to search the descriptions of a chat room, click Also Search Descriptions.
- 3 Click Go To.

#### **Tips**

- If you are looking for another person, type their nickname in the Containing User Nickname box. If you want to begin another search, click Reset.

To view the chat history

To see previous frames of the conversation, scroll up in the viewing pane.

## To change a character's expression

- 1 In the emotion wheel, drag the black dot to an emotion.
- 2 Right-click, and then click Send Expression. The character's expression in the most recent pane changes.

#### To freeze a character's expression

- 1 Click the black dot in the center of the emotion wheel, and then drag it to the expression you want.
- 2 Right-click, and then click Frozen.

  Each frame displays the emotion you have selected until you unfreeze the emotion.

# Tip

To unfreeze a character's expression, point to the emotion wheel, right-click, and then click Frozen.

## To ignore a character

- 1 Select a character by right-clicking their icon or nickname in the Member List pane.
- 2 On the context menu, right-click Ignore.

Messages from this person no longer appear in your conversation panels. Others in the chat room can still see them.

## To work offline

On the File menu, click New, and then click Cancel.

#### To define a character's emotion

• Click the black dot in the center of the circle, and then drag it around the wheel.

You can choose eight different emotions for your character:

Shouting Angry
Happy Laughing
Bored Scared
Sad Coy

The character in the Self-view pane displays each emotion as you move around the circle. The closer to the outer edge of the wheel you move the dot, the more extreme the emotion; the closer to the center, the more moderate.

#### Note

Not all characters display the full range of emotions.

## **Comic Chat Keyboard Shortcuts**

CTRL+A	Selects all text in compose window.			
CTRL+C	Copies selected text from compose window to the Clipboard.			
CTRL+D	Deletes selected text from the compose window.			
CTRL+I	Send Action. Sends text from the compose window to the chat pane, as a caption.			
CTRL+N	Closes the current chat session and opens a new connection.			
CTRL+O	Opens a file.			
CTRL+P	Prints a file.			
CTRL+R	Ring. Sends a page to a character you select.			
CTRL+S	Saves a file.			
CTRL+T	Sends the contents of the compose window as a thought.			
CTRL+V	Pastes the Clipboard contents to the compose window.			
CTRL+W	Sends the contents of the compose window as a whisper.			
CTRL+X	Cuts the selected text to the Clipboard.			
CTRL+Y	Sends the contents of the compose window.			
CTRL+Z	Undo. Reverses the most recent action in the compose window.

#### To specify a connection

The following options are available to you in the Connect dialog box.

#### Favorites

Displays your favorite chat rooms. In the list, select the room you want to enter.

#### Server

Displays the chat room server. In the box, type the name of the server where the chat room is located.

#### Port

Displays the port number for the server. In the box, type the name of the port number where the server is located. The default port number is 6667.

#### **Connect to Specific Channel**

Displays the channel for the chat room. In the box, type the name of the channel where the chat room is located.

#### **Connect to Server and List Channels**

Specifies that you want to connect to a server and have a list of channels to choose from when entering a chat room.

#### To specify general settings

On the View menu, click OptionsThe Settings tab contains the following options.

#### Prompt to Save the Conversation on Exit

Specifies to save your chat room dialogue when you quit Comic Chat.

#### **Don't Send Graphic Information**

Specifies to not send your comic (graphical) chat information to all related members of a chat room.

#### **Panel Layout**

Displays the Comic Chat window in panes. In the list, select the amount of panes you want to display.

#### To modify your personal information

On the View menu, click Options, and then click Personal Info.

### Type a Nickname

Provides a space for you to type your online nickname. In the box, type a name you want to use as a nickname.

#### Type a Real Name

Provides a space for you to type your real name. In the box, type your real name.

#### Type a Brief Description of Self

Provides a space for you to type a personal description for others to view when you are in a chat room.

#### To choose a character

- 1. On the View menu, click Options, and then click the Characters tab.
- 2. In the Character Name list, click the character that you want. The Preview box displays a preview of the selected character. You can click the emotion wheel to see what the character looks like in different moods.

#### **Character Name**

Lists the names of the comic characters you can select to represent you when you are in a chat room. In the list, select the character you want.

#### **Preview**

Displays a preview of the character in a chat room.

## To choose a background

- 1. On the View menu, click Options, and then click the Backgrounds tab.
- 2. In the Background list, click the background that you want. The Preview box displays a preview of the selected background.

#### **Background**

Displays the names of backgrounds you can use in the comic strip. In the list, click the background that you want.

#### **Preview**

Displays a preview of the selected background.
