Overview

ivMail is a simple to use add-on for Netscape Mail, Microsoft Internet Mail, Eudora Pro 3.0, and most other Internet E-Mail programs which allows you to easily send and receive voice messages over the Internet. ivMail will automaticly work with any Internet E-Mail client that will start an application or helper thru file associations. Incoming voice messages appear as attached files (links) in your incomming mail. To play the audio message, simply click on the link. Outgoing voice messages are prepared and sent using ivMail's easy and intuitive user interface.

System Requirements

- 486/33 or better PC running Microsoft Windows 95 or Windows NT
- 8 megabytes RAM
- 4 megabytes free disk space
- An installed sound card and speakers
- A microphone for preparing voice messages
- Either a direct connection or a modem connection with a SLIP or PPP to an Internet Service Provider
- E-Mail Client Software Netscape Navigator ver. 2.0 or greater (which includes Netscape Mail), Microsoft Internet Explorer (which includes Internet Mail), Eudora Pro 3.0, or any E-Mail software that will auto-start a helper application to view attached files.

Configuration

ivMail Configuration - After starting ivMail, click on File, then Configuration. Enter your Host Name. Host Name is the fully-qualified domain name of your E-Mail server, such as "yourhost.com." Enter your full E-Mail Address, such as you@yourhost.com. Click on Save.

Using ivMail

Sending a Message - After starting ivMail, enter a recipient for your message. This is the full Internet E-Mail address where you want the message sent. Enter a subject for your message (optional). Click on the "Rec" (Record) button and speak your voice message into the microphone. Click on the "Stop" button to end recording. You may listen to the message before sending by clicking on the "Play" button. To re-record the message (start over), click on the "New" button and repeat the steps above. When the message is prepared, click on the "Send" button. ivMail will compress the message and send it. When the title bar indicates M"essage Sent," you can close ivMail or click on the "New" button to prepare another message.

Receiving a Message - ivMail voice messages are received using you regular E-Mail software. ivMail voice messages will appear as files attached to the E-Mail message. ivMail voice messages will have "ivMail" as the beginning of the message subject and the audio message will appear as the attached file. To play the audio message, simply click on the attached file - your E-Mail software will start ivMail and load the audio message. To listen to the message, click the "Play" button.

Benefits of Registration

Registered users receive the following:

- · The Address Book will become enabled.
- The Carbon Copy (CC) function will become enabled.
- You will be entitled to free registered upgrades as they become available.
- · All "Nag Screens" and "UNREGISTERED" indicators will re removed.
